- 6. When it's time for your appointment, let your teacher know and come on down.




Guide to reading an Ontario Student Status Sheet

On the back of this sheet is a copy of your Ontario Student Status. This document is used by secondary schools to track your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) requirements as you progress through secondary school. This document is not to be confused with an Ontario Student Transcript, which is used for post-secondary institutions, employers and a number of other purposes. Please check this document carefully to ensure all the information is accurate and that you are either on track or meeting your OSSD requirements.

Please check for the following OSSD requirements:

- Community Involvement Hours: minimum of 40 hours required
- Online Learning Graduation Requirement Students must complete TWO of their 30 credits as an Online Learning course OR opt-out of the requirement. Please see Guidance for more information.
- Ontario Secondary School Literacy Requirement Either by passing the literacy test or taking the literacy course (OLC4O)
- 18 Compulsory Credits
- 12 Optional Credits

Applying to Ontario Universities



Application Deadline: Thursday, January 15, 2025

- Fees:
 - \$156.00 for <u>three</u> choices
 - Applicants who wish to select additional programs or universities beyond the first three choices must pay \$50.00 for each additional selection
 - International service fee: \$10
 - **Supplemental Program Fees**: some universities charge additional fees for certain programs to cover the cost of individual faculty admission processes; it is non-refundable and you pay it along with your OUAC application fee

Build confidence when making decisions!

Before researching and collecting information about schools and programs:

- Review/consider factors that might impact your decisions
- create a list of factors that are most important to <u>YOU</u> !



When creating a list of factors that are MOST important to you. Consider...

- Size of Campus
- Setting of Campus (urban/rural)
- Location Proximity to home
- Competitive or Popular Programs
- Specialized/Unique Programs (International, etc.)
- Residence/Housing
- Transportation
- Class Size
- Special Education Services
- Teams/Clubs
- Extra Help/Tutoring
- Libraries, Computer Labs, Other Educational Facilities
- Career Planning Services

- Social & Recreational Opportunities/Facilities
- Meal Plans/Food
- Part-Time Employment Opportunities
- Financial Aid, Scholarships, Bursaries
- Tuition Fees
- Graduate Program Opportunities/Professional Programs
- Admission Requirements
- Transfer Opportunities (to other colleges or universities)
- Mental Health Support
- Experiential Learning Programs/Opportunities (eg. Coop, internships)
- Post Graduate Employability/Job Placement

Admission Requirements:

- What are the prerequisite courses required for my program of interest?
- Are there any additional admission requirements for my program of interest beside marks? A portfolio, audition, additional application form, Personal Statement Essay (PSE)?
- What is the projected cut-off average for my program of interest?
- Is there admission testing that I have to do to get into the program? (Note: Many colleges use a combination of admission testing and high school marks.)
- Does your school/my program of interest accept courses taken at night school, summer school and/or private school?

- visit <u>university</u>, <u>college</u>, <u>apprenticeship</u> and <u>workplace</u> application websites
- visit individual university, college, apprenticeship or workplace websites

- interview students, graduates or employees
- review post-secondary literature, viewbooks, media


OSAP
