EQAO Results from last year - available online. Math scores (Gr 3 and 6) comparatively low vs Province. Level 4s were low compared to Board. Province and Board-wide math scores are low. Reading and writing on par. Kids going through test faster now that it's online - need to figure out how to slow them down. Parents anecdotally sharing that high school math very challenging for kids today - lots of additional resources being put to it. Jump math is one. This year's EQAO will be end of May/beginning of June.

Whole School Activity Plan (Skating – Wednesdays in Feb) - Clippers Arena and Stouffville Arena (Feb 7, 14, 21, 28). 2 buses/day. Ice: \$3729 Bus: ?? \$10/student. Starting to figure out how many students need skates and helmets - might need to do a skate drive. Will need lots of helpers for these days. Get the ice all day. Ms Holtzman organizing. Can high school students come to help for these days?? Alison/Mr Innes will follow up

Student Council for Intermediates: Starting a student council. Ms Price, Ms Calvert, and Ms Marden will work with them. Mr. B's class has traditionally planned all the spirit days, we want to give a voice to more of the students.

School Fees: New - \$10/student in gr 6, 7, 8 for music. \$0 for agendas or learning materials. Anything required for learning we can't charge for. Don't really need instruments to learn music so we are charging a flat fee for students that participate in instrumental to cover the cost of the reeds/maintenance/cleaning. Mr. Alfonso now here 4 days a week and has been fixing up all the instruments. Maybe Kiwanis at the end of the year, maybe high school performance.
