EQAO assessment: Students have finished participating in grade 3 and 6 EQAO 2016. The Primary EQAO assessments review the skills and knowledge accumulated from Kindergarten to grade 3. The Junior EQAO assessments review the skills and knowledge acquired from K to grade 6. All students write the grade 9 Mathematics EQAO. The grade 10 OSSLT is the final standardized Literacy test and a pass is required to graduate from Secondary school. The stafft Soutton PS and throughout YRDSB continue to use the data gathered from EQAO to inform school planning, to guide professional learning and to inform classroom instructional decisions. 
