
 Council agreed to transfer the unspent balance of \$1733.86 from the Playground account to the Fundraising account.

Tree and Playground Report

- RL reported on the condition and maintenance of the trees that have been planted in the schoolyard over the last several years
 - Trees have been pruned for shape and to remove dead/damaged limbs
 - Failing hackberry tree in the kindergarten garden will be replaced by RL in late May or June
 - Grass will be reseeded between the playground and drainage swale where it was damaged when the drainage was improved. The area will be roped off through the spring and summer.

YRDSB Parent Symposium – Parent Voice Matters!

- PH and SPS Vice-Principal S. Dickson attended a workshop presented by Aldergrove Public School (Markham) about ongoing efforts at their school to "Engage Parents, Families, Elders and Community to support student achievement"
- Topics included:
 - Beginning-of-year questionnaire to learn about methods of communication, language/translation, preferred meeting times, important dates and celebrations
 - Beginning-of-year orientation evening for families new to the school
 - Town Hall-style meetings to gather community input on goals, expectations, issues
 - o Family activity nights to allow families to connect with the school community together
 - End-of-year Community Report Card to gather data and track whether the school is successful in meeting goals and expectations and where gaps are occurring
- In light of the rapid growth of our school population, Council will consider organizing an orientation session in the fall for families new to our school

2018-2019 PRO Grant

 this \$1000 grant is June 5, 2018
