Students will receive 6 ½ community hours for their participation in this event. Parents are expected to pick up their child at the school at 10:00pm.

It is important to remind parents/guardians and students of the following expectations during the **12 HOUR** event:

- Students are to keep to their assigned areas in the school at all times.
(You will not disrupt classes during the day portion of the event)
- Students are not permitted to leave school grounds.
- Students must keep their area clean and tidy and remove all garbage.
- Parents may visit on the evening of the 30th from 7:00pm to 8:30pm.
- Students must bring a reusable water bottle and their own snacks and drinks for the event.
- We will provide dinner, but you are responsible for your own lunch during the day.
- This is a school event and all school rules apply.

To uphold the integrity of this event, it is mandatory that each student complete a mural within the designated Art areas. If there is a situation that arises that is deemed to be inappropriate, the teachers and administration in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the York Region District School Board will determine the best course of action for the student.
