Subject: Georgina Historical Society Nena Marsden Memorial Bursary

We are a not-for-profit volunteer organization dedicated to collecting preserving, promoting and interpreting the rich history and heritage of all communities now known as the Town of Georgina.

Each year, our Society sponsors an essay competition for the Nena Marsden Memorial Bursary in the amount of \$500.00. All graduating students who reside in the Town of Georgina and who will be attending a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2021 are eligible. A Committee of judges will review each submission to determine which student will be the recipient of the Bursary.

The criteria are as follows:

(a) Open to all graduating students residing in the Town of Georgina and entering post-secondary school In 2021,

(b) Format either (i) a 1000 to 1200 word essay or

(ii) a multimedia essay –Vvideo or Power Point – 3 to 5 minutes in length and Windows compatible,

(C) Topic – There have been many times during recorded history when people have been faced with extraordinary challenges during pandemics. What have we learned from past pandemics that we can apply to our current situation?

(d) Deadline – Monday May 31, 2021

For the sole purpose of promoting Canada's proud heritage, please be advised that all submitted images, copy and communications to our bursary program/multimedia exhibit are subject to being distributed via all forms of traditional and new media. While no one will be financially compensated for submissions of this nature, we all benefit by letting everyone else know what we all know...that history is worth exploring and celebrating. It is the responsibility of the entrant to retain copyright permissions, where necessary.
