Entry and Dismissal Routines:

Thank you once again to all parents/guardians who are adhering to our new routines in regards to dropping off your child/children and picking them up. It is imperative that families remain off of the tarmac during these times in order for our students to safely enter and exit the building and to reduce the risk of spreading Covid-19. I once again ask all parents/guardians to arrange for a meeting spot off of the tarmac so that we can work together to keep everyone safe.

Another reminder that once the dismissal bell rings at 2:50 p.m. that all students and parents/guardians are to exit the school grounds. Playing on the tarmac or the playground before or after school puts the students at risk, as it means that students would be exposed to students



outside of their cohort. The closure of school grounds, including the playground equipment, is consistent amongst all YRDSB elementary schools and we greatly appreciate your understanding of this matter.

Parent-Teacher Interviews:

Family Virtual Conferences will be held on November 12th and November 13th. You will have an opportunity to meet with your child(ren)'s teacher(s) and learn more about the classroom. We regret that for health and safety reasons, we are unable to host an event at the school as we normally would, however we look forward to meeting with you virtually.

Families can use Edsby, an online platform, to schedule a meeting time with their child(ren)'s teacher(s) on Parents' Night. You will receive an invitation to sign up for a meeting time once the schedules are available.

Edsby is a cloud-based platform that lets families easily reserve times to meet with your child(ren)'s teachers. YRDSB in partnership with Edsby have created a secure platform that protects the privacy of information for families.

Families that already have an Edsby account may use their previously created account. The username is the full email address that is on file at your child(ren)'s home school and the password is the one created at activation. If you have forgotten your password, you can find resources on the Board website to help, including how to reset your password.

Families who do not have an Edsby account will need to create one to access the online appointment scheduler for their child's teachers for the virtual conference. An up-to-date and valid email address must be provided to your child's home school. For help creating an Edsby account, instructions can be found on the Board website. An email from York Region District School Board with instructions on how to create an Edsby account will be sent to your email inbox. If you do not receive the email, please check your junk mail folder to ensure you do not miss this opportunity.
