What's happening here? *Why?*







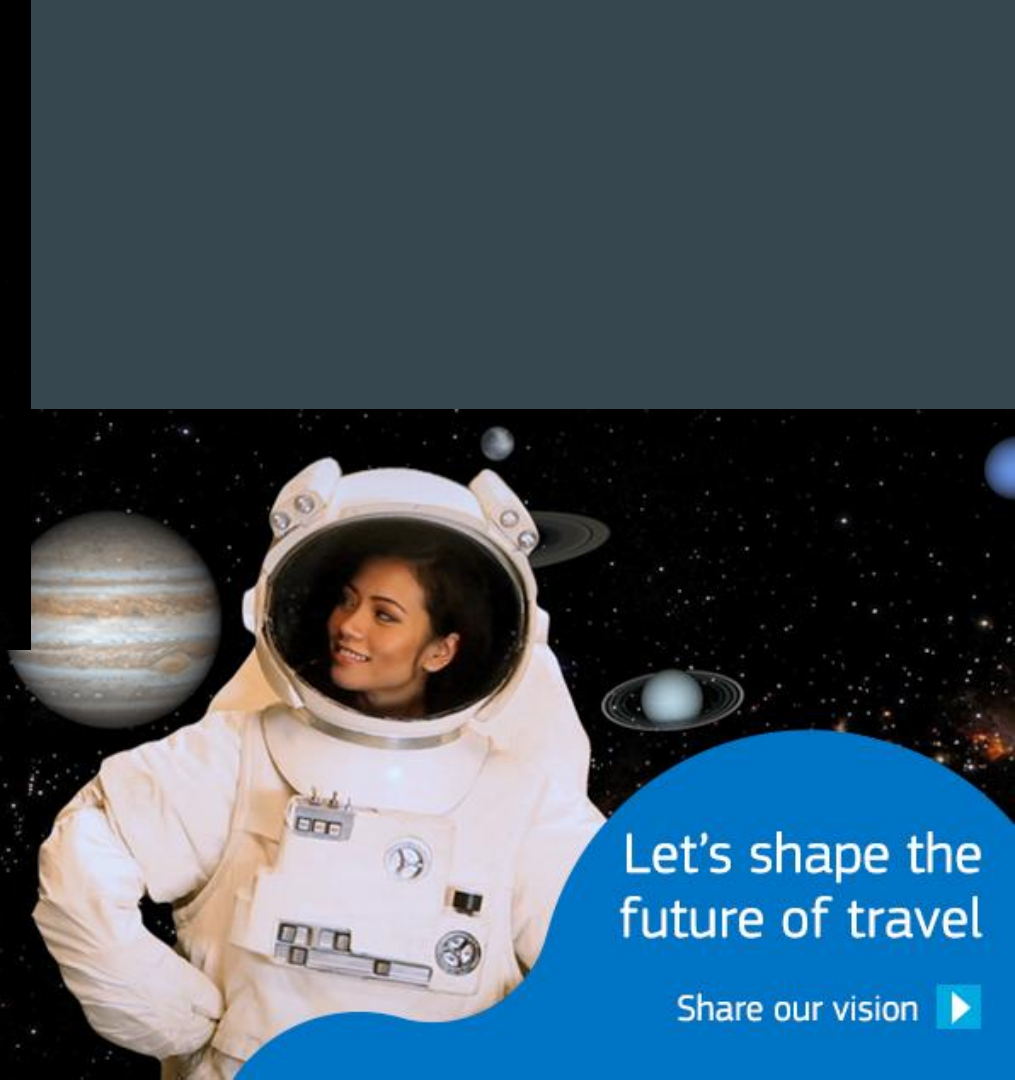

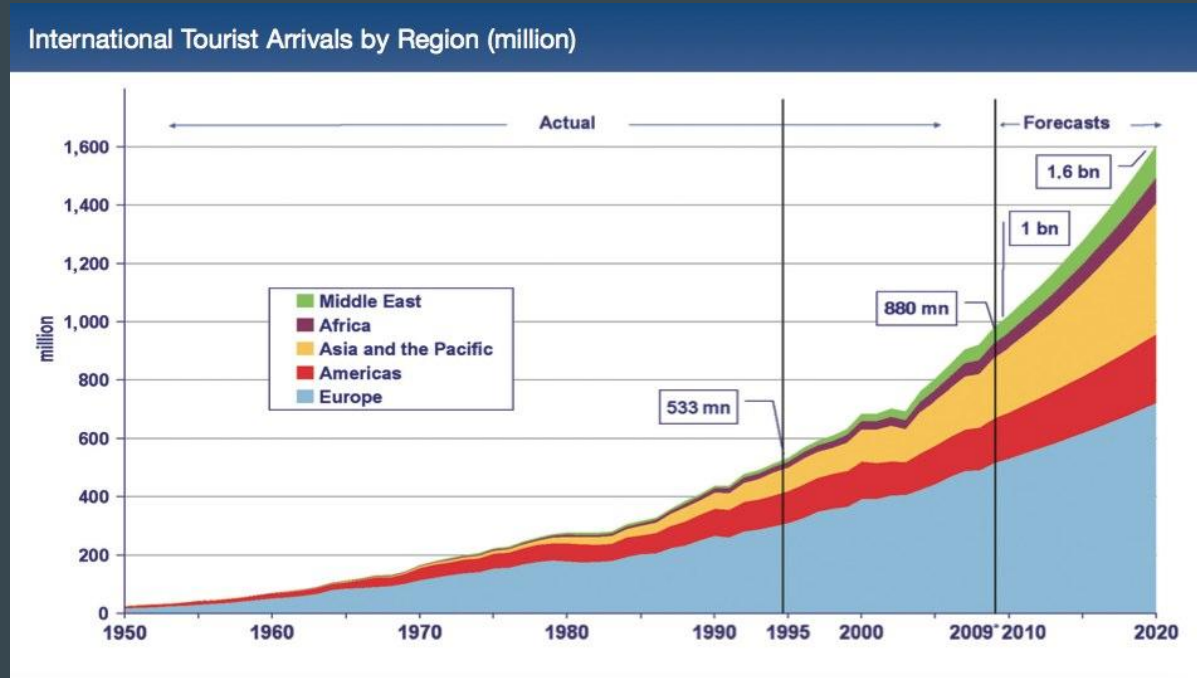
