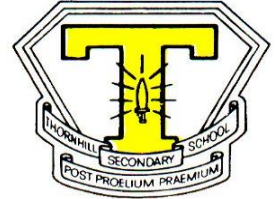


Grade 8 Registration Procedures for Out of Area YRDSB and NON-YRDSB Students



NON-YRDSB STUDENTS

Thornhill Secondary School – 2020/21

If my child attends a non-YRDSB school, but lives in or is moving into the catchment area for Thornhill Secondary School and would like to attend Thornhill Secondary School for September 2020, how do we register them?

1. Book an appointment with a Vice-Principal to pre-register for September 2020. Please contact our guidance office to book an appointment. You will need to bring the following documents to your appointment:
 - proof of residency (e.g., tax/hydro bill or lease/rental agreement)
 - birth verification (i.e., birth certificate, passport or citizenship card)
 - grade 8 report card
 - IEP (if applicable)
 - Exchange of Information
2. Pick up the following from the TSS Guidance Office:
 - YRDSB Secondary Student Registration Form
 - Course Selection Sheet
 - Course Selection Planning Sheet (lists all compulsory & elective grade 9 courses)
 - Course Calendar
3. Refer to the *Thornhill Secondary School* website for a complete list of courses offered. Click on the *Guidance* tab, then *Course Offerings*, where you will find the *School Course Calendar*.
4. Complete the registration and course selection forms and submit both to our guidance secretary.

Out of Area YRDSB STUDENTS

Thornhill Secondary School – 2020/21

If my child is a current YRDSB student, but not in the Thornhill Secondary School catchment area, can we apply for a transfer?

Student transfer requests will be considered by the Superintendent of Schools. Student transfers are granted when both space and program are available.

Grade 8 students submit Transfer Request forms, along with their Registration Form to their elementary schools by the beginning of February. Students currently attending secondary schools submit their Transfer Request Form to their principal.
