1. CMHA Presentation on mental health by 45min – cancelled. Alternate speaker available - council parent to address questions from parents attending with interest in this topic

Dr. Ralph Lewis - Psychiatrist @ Sunnybrook – specializing in youth issues

Addressed parent questions including:

- How does a parent differentiate between children who are experiencing normal adolescent issues versus those who might have an actual mental disorder?
- Is there a risk of waiting until children are 25 before investigating mental illness?
- What should we be looking for as symptoms of depression & anxiety in our kids?
- Which disorders are more prevalent in males or females?
- Where does normality end and abnormality begin?
 - Labels as distinct entities overlap with normality and with each other
 - The main factor to consider is whether the symptoms are causing significant impairment in functioning
 - Occur along a continuum of symptoms
 - Can include loss of function or regression
 - Indicators of distress (of self or others affected by them).
 - Often connected with substance abuse which is both cause and effect of mental illness (alcohol and marijuana).

Symptoms of Depression

- = loss of interest (in life).
- = Finding things unrewarding and unpleasurable and unfulfilling.
- = Eventual social withdrawal and isolation but not always immediately.
- = Fatigue, loss of energy & other changes

Symptoms of Anxiety

= highly avoidance behavior (which is self-reinforcing)

Causes of mental disorders

- = combination of biological, psychological & social factors
- = innate vulnerability & environmental stress factors
