Minutes of the Meeting of the Thornhill Secondary School Council Meeting held on September 12, 2019

Call to Order

Anna Sit, Chair of last academic year called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

Welcome:

The Chair welcomed the parents and staff to the first meeting of the school year 2019/2020.

Student Council Report:

Janice (student), president of BOSS, spoke briefly on BOSS and the activities the club assists with. Janice noted the importance of paying the Student Activities Fee through School Cash Online: it funds the student activities throughout the year such as semi-formal, Terry Fox Fun & Carnival. All these activities are organized and run by the students. Paying this fee, assists in offsetting the cost of the activities and it is cheaper for students who paid and attend the activities.

It was noted that some parents could not find "Student Activities Fees" in School Cash online; the Principal will look into this issue.

School Council Report 2018-2019:

The Chair noted that for the past academic year, each meeting aimed to include presentations that provided parents with tips on how to help our kids to succeed in high school. e.g. Grade 10 OSSLT, Grade 9 EQAO, College & university pathway, outside speak - Andy Thibodeau on "Share your care".

The Chair informed the meeting that the fundraising budget as of June 2019 is \$1830.94.

School Council Elections for 2019-2020:

The Chair spoke briefly on the role of the School Council and circulated a handout. She noted that more information could be obtained online from "YRDSB School Council Handbook" November 2015 edition, "School Council Constitution" specifically for TSS from TSS website/ School Council.

With the posts being vacated, the election process commenced with the completion and/or submission of nomination forms.

Debbie Ziegler, Principal conducted the election process with the assistance of Kandeephan Ganeshalingam and Georgia Vatousis, Vice-Principals.

Breakfast Club

The Chair reported that the School Council donates funds to school annually as well as awards scholarships to two Grade 12 students .

The Council also assists with donations to the Breakfast Club at TSS.

Catherine De Angelo, teacher and founder of the Breakfast Club noted that this is the 3rd year of the programme and stated that approximately 200 students benefit. Ms. De Angelo gave a brief description of the breakfast items provided for the students who partake in the breakfast programme.

Ms. De Angelo stated that the Breakfast Club was in need of a fridge and a music box. Mr. Nader, parent, donated 2 fridges and an electric stove (if the stove can be used).

Ms. De Angelo noted that with the provincial cuts in the budget, funds are needed to start the programme and sought a donation from the School Council.

On a motion duly moved, seconded and unanimously carried, the Council Members approved the donation to the Breakfast Club in the amount of \$500 from the Fundraising budget.

Ms. Caryn Zusman, parent, made a personal donation in the amount of \$500 to match the amount donated by the Council.
