Student IT Team Service - mission statement. To promote opportunities for staff and students to work together as they navigate digital tools that enhance learning.

Want to integrate the digital tools into the classroom

To support board program called TTEP. (Teacher Technology Engagement Program.)

Team meets Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays. 3 -4L00 pm after school in library.

The group can help with "Green Tools" which are board owned and operated. Supported and accessible to all students via their log-in.

"Red Tools" are non-board supported one.

Emphasis on Google Education tools.

Program was new in April with a "soft" roll-out. Next steps are promotion, training members, promotion and planning for 2016-17.

Presented by Sanjna and Gabriella. Grade 11 students.

Idea came thru Ms. Earl's Urban Planning class about a year ago.

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Looking to foster a sense of community, outdoor education, space for music, and area to gather as well as general greening of the school & community.

Goal is to foster a sense of community while enriching the school environment and creating an eco-friendly educational space.

School council's mission statement overlaid with the this group shows a lot of common ground.

Proposed area is immediately east of the student parking lot, between the lot and the south wing of the school.

Could be used as an outdoor classroom, open mike nights, club meeting space.

Phase 2 is planned to include a garden. For a club and classroom resource. Maintenance could be handled by the "Eco-Action Club" as well as community partners who could handle in the summer.

Looking for the parents council to take stewardship of garden slots and financial support in our school enrichment project.

Total investment is expected to about \$27,000 to handle initial construction.

Students suggest that rain barrels could provide water requirements in case a water line is not available on that side of the building.

Time line is for construction to take place in May 2017.

Shirley invited the group to present to the next Parents Council in the fall.

ProGrant request has been submitted for next school year. Focusing on mental well-being, math literacy, social media literacy. \$1000 should be approved for the program over the summer.

 - a. Spring 2010 (Carol Green/Georgia)

Parent's Voice Matter. Presented on March 9 by Michelle Cassidy. "Putting the Health in Mental Health". Three main points – What is the thing I could start doing that would have the biggest impact on my life, also suggest writing in a daily gratitude journal, and also identify what we really love in life and makes us happy.

Second workshop. "Change How I Feel". Point was if we don't feel good in our minds, we don't feel well in our bodies. We are in control of our feelings. Suggests 1) Meditation, 2) Accu-Pressure www.fastereft.com, and 3) Picture Switching. Take a picture of something that makes you really happy. Make it bigger and bigger in your mind. Then do the same exercise with a negative influence – but make that smaller and minimize it. Finally in your mind, place the small picture in front of the large happy image in hope that the happy will over whelm the negative one.

Final Presentation . Math learning for elementary students.
