		As of last parent council meeting for 2016-17 academic year on May 2, 2017, parent council has \$982.63 which are <u>non-board</u> funds (i.e. gathered from donations and fund-raising).		
		Cash Online allows people to donate online and funds are directed to the parent council. There is a Sunshine Fund, which provides economic support to students for clothing. This fund is not internet-based, but money can be allocated to this fund by the Parent Council.

		There is a bulletin board outside the cafeteria with a 5x5 calendar containing updates for clubs.

		There was a carnival at the end of September. Students enjoyed themselves.

happened because it is handled by the police.

#### d. Fundraising directions

Donations of \$25 or greater receive tax receipts. Over the past 2 years, about \$1500 has been raised each year. This is a significant decrease from 10 years ago, when council raised about \$10,000 in a year. TSS cannot solicit donations electronically because of the new legislation. Technology is still a need at TSS. Ms. DiAngelo could ask TSS staff about needs.
