- a. 2017 Parent Council Fundraising Letter: Goal is to improve availability of and access to mobile digital technology and other aids for students in need. School staff will decide what equipment is needed.
- b. Volunteers for lunch period: Ms. Vatoussis reached out to Thornhill church across the street to ask them for space for our students to go during their lunch period, because the cafeteria and the

library are both very busy then. Goal is for students to go somewhere to spend their time wisely. Ms. Vatoussis has met with students who said they would use the church space. Student participation in the lunch program at the church would be voluntary, not mandatory. The church are happy to give us the space because our school is close by. TSS may start to use the space gradually, e.g. 1 day per week at first. The challenge is supervision of students during the lunch periods. Administration is looking for volunteers to supervise students during lunch at the church. Volunteers would need to obtain a Vulnerable Sector Screening from the police. Volunteers could be parents or retired teachers. Currently, the church runs an afterschool program for students from E.J. Sand P.S. Administration will post information about this volunteering opportunity in the parent bulletin. If there is an incident during a lunch period, volunteer supervisor can approach church staff, who are in the building, for assistance. Lunch periods are 11:20 a.m. to 12:35 p.m. and 12:45 to 2:00 p.m.

c. Pro-Grant Topics – Kate Jones and Associates: Parent council meeting participants voted on the various topics. The top 2 choices were: Raising Positive Resilient and Happy Kids! And Surviving Your Adolescents: How to Manage and Let Go of Your 13-18 Years Olds. Anna Sit, co-chair will contact this company and try to arrange a presentation for the January Parent Council Meeting. There is also the possibility of collaborating with Thornlea, Westmount and the elementary feeder schools, for hosting a presentation.
