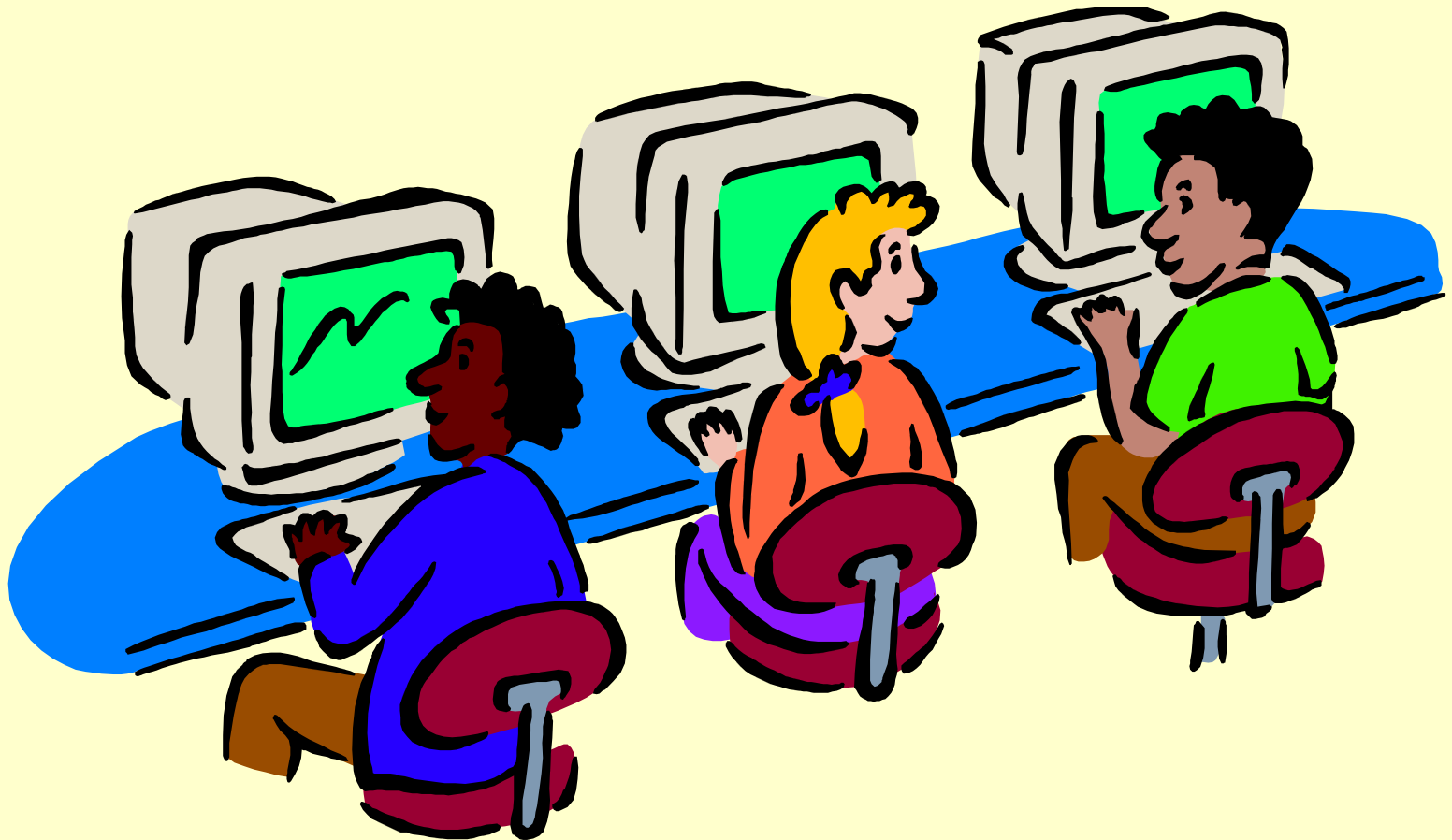

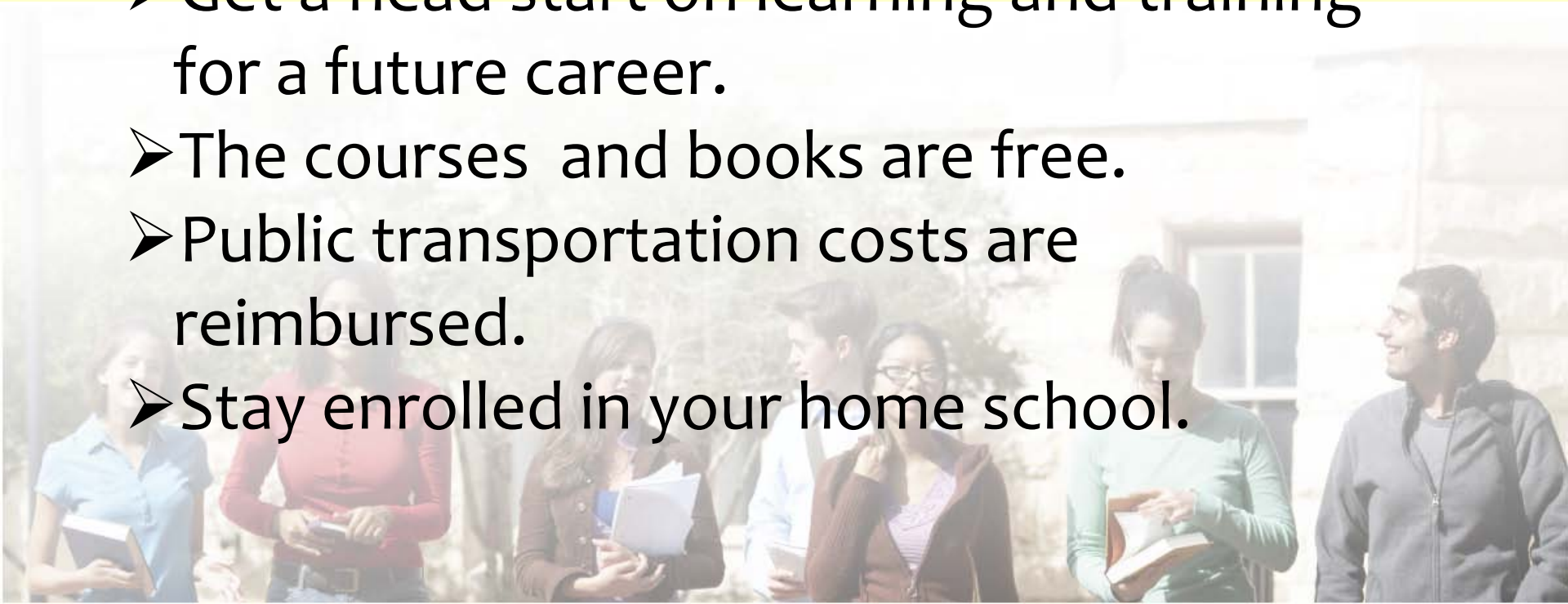
## Who is taking dual credit courses?

Students who:

- often only need a few more credits to graduate
  - want to check out college before they leave high school
  - are looking for a new learning environment
  - want get a head start in a SHSM program
- 

## What's in it for you?

- Get a head start on learning and training for a future career.
- The courses and books are free.
- Public transportation costs are reimbursed.
- Stay enrolled in your home school.



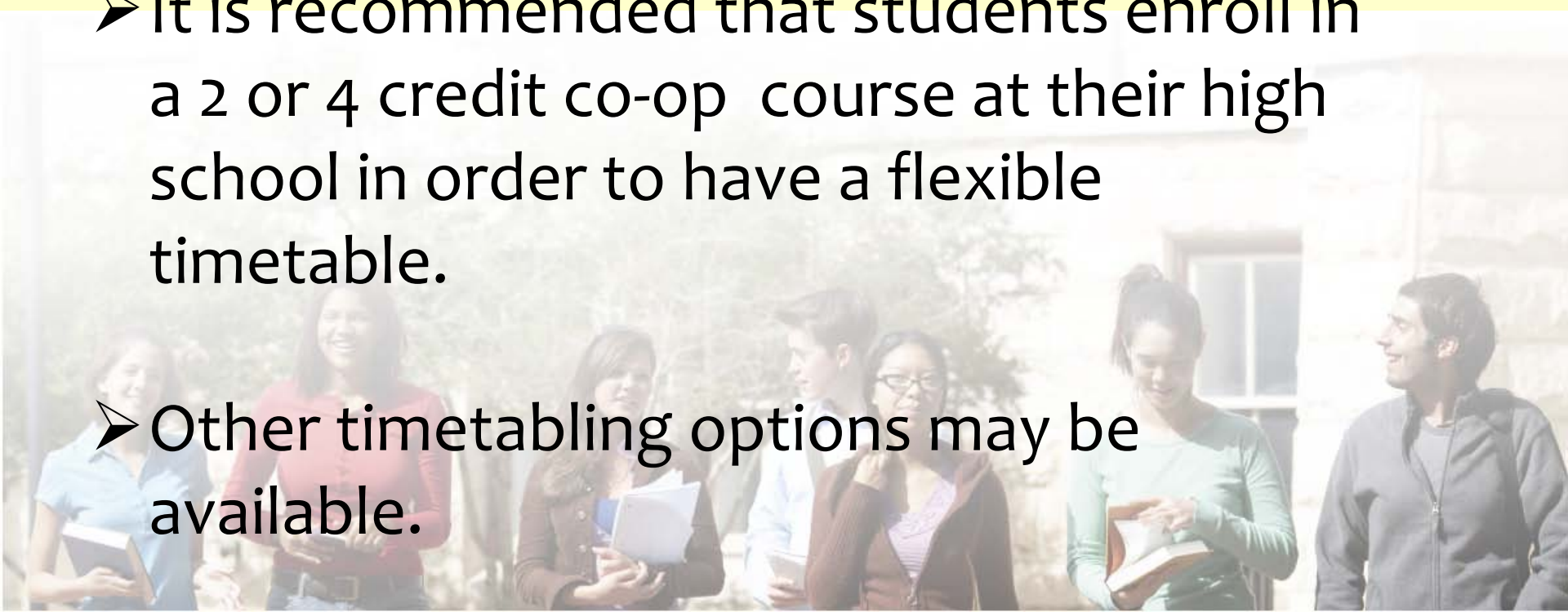


## So how does this work?

- Apply at your home school through your guidance department.
- Take one or two college courses, which run once or twice per week at the college.
- For each college course successfully completed students receive both the college credit and a high school credit.

## What if you still need more high school credits?

- It is recommended that students enroll in a 2 or 4 credit co-op course at their high school in order to have a flexible timetable.
- Other timetabling options may be available.





# Dual Credit on Career Cruising

- Choose a Dual Credit as an elective course.
- The holding codes for Dual Credit courses are:  
YYY4X1 for one course  
YYY4X2 for two courses  
YYY4x3 for three courses  
YYY4X4 for four courses
- Selecting a course on Career Cruising is only the start of the application process. Please see your guidance counsellor to review course offerings.
- Guidance will assist you with the application process.
