accepted as the European standard for language proficiency.




The Modern Languages

Our programs:

CORE FRENCH

FSF1D1 Grade 9, Academic

Who should be in this course?

- All students who achieve over 70% in grade 8 French and have mastered the grade 8 curriculum expectations.
- Students below 70% may still take this course and be successful if they show good work ethic
- Students who take all their other subjects at the academic level.

FSF1P1 Grade 9, Applied

Who should be in this course?

- All students who achieve below 70% in grade 8 French.
- Students who are experiencing difficulty in the subject.
- Students taking other subjects at the applied level.

FSF10 OPEN/BEGINNER

Who should be in this course?

- This introductory course is designed for students who have had fewer than 600hrs of French in elementary school
- Usually students coming from another province or country would qualify to take this be-

Why continue taking French after grade 9?

- Strengthen problem-solving, reasoning and creative thinking skills; develop an understanding and appreciation of diverse cultures and increase competitiveness in an increasingly global job market.
- Your marketable skills in the global economy are improved if you master another language.
- Analytical skills improve when students study a foreign language.
- Foreign languages open the door to art, music, dance, fashion, cuisine, film, philosophy, science...
- French is, along with English, the only language spoken on all five continents

- -Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology (gr 11)
- -Co-operative education (gr 11)
- -World Issues (gr 12)

Why French Immersion at Thornlea?

- -Opportunity to combine multiple enriched programs such as FI/ACAM/AP;
- -Students in FI can concurrently take ACAM courses in French to meet the requirements of both certificates;
- -Our French Immersion students are among the most successful candidates on the AP exams. In particular, they achieve superior results on the French AP exam. These high scores are often accepted by universities towards first year credits.
