Message From the Principal

Dear Thornlea Families,

As most of you are aware the rules around masking and cohorting at schools were changed as of March 21st. The wearing of masks is now optional and some staff and students have chosen to remove their masks but the vast majority continue to wear a mask at school. wheat germ pudding samanu (affluence/sweetness), sumac(the colour of sunrise), vinegar (age and patience) and others.
