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Message From the Principal

Dear Thornlea Families.

There has been a great deal of activity at Thornlea taking place over the last few weeks. Our students in grade 12 have been writing AP exams. These exams are written at the same time all over the world and are set by the College Board at Princeton University. If a student is successful on the exam they can receive advanced standing at University which will allow them to gain a first year university credit. The exams are very challenging and take a great deal of preparation. We wish all our AP students good luck on their exams.

Our students are also preparing for the grade ten EQAO literacy test. This is a graduation requirement and it must be completed before students graduate with their Ontario Secondary School Diploma. Below is some important information for all our students.

OSSLT REMINDER

The spring administration of the OSSLT will take place on **Tuesday May 10th** for the students in Grade 10 and **Wednesday May 11th** for the students in Grade 11 and non-graduating Grade 12 students who did not participate in, or were not successful in the fall administration. Unlike the fall administration, the assessment days will **not** be asynchronous.

All students in grades 9, 11, and 12 who are not participating in the test will follow the regular school schedule and attend all classes as usual. Grade 10 students not participating in the spring OSSLT assessment are required to attend school and will engage in learning to build upon reading and writing skills in preparation for the next OSSLT assessment and complete any outstanding work.

Thornlea is running a full slate of spring sports and it is nice to see our students outside on our fields practicing rugby, soccer, track and field, flag football, ultimate Frisbee and coed Volleyball. Our drama students are busy putting together the final show of the year. Finally I would like to remind everyone that our final School Council meeting will take place online on Monday May 16th at 7:00 p.m. An invite will be sent to parents closer to the date.

College and University Applicants

- → Graduating students who plan to attend college or university in September should continue to check their OCAS and OUAC accounts and their email on a regular basis. College bound students should have received a response from the colleges that they applied to and can expect to receive communication about payment of fees, with mid-June being the earliest that colleges can require payment of tuition fees.
- → A reminder that all offers are CONDITIONAL upon the receipt of final grades in July students should continue to work hard to ensure the required final average.

University Applications:

→ Important Notice for all grade 12's that have applied through OUAC for university!

Your mid-term grades from semester two have been processed by OUAC and sent to the Universities to which you have applied. Please log on to your online application in order to review your academic information. This verification is especially important if OUAC does not have a valid email address on file, or you are not able to receive emails from OUAC/your Universities because of a junk-mail setting with you inbox. If you see an error in your OUAC file, it is very important that you contact your Guidance Counselor as soon as possible to have it corrected.



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→ We highly recommend you accept your offer before the **deadline of June 1st**. You should be contacted by **May 27th** if you have been accepted into your program. The next OUAC transmission will be on **July 7th**.

→ University bound students should verify the deadline for <u>payment to secure a space in residence (usually June 1st).</u>

College Applications:

- → Important Notice for all grade 12's that have applied through OCAS for college!
 - Your mid-term grades from semester two have been processed by OCAS and sent to the Colleges to which you have applied. Please log on to your online application in order to review your academic information. This verification is especially important if OCAS does not have a valid email address on file, or you are not able to receive emails from OCAS/your Colleges because of a junk-mail setting with you inbox. If you see an error in your OCAS file, it is very important that you contact your Guidance Counselor as soon as possible to have it corrected.
- → The "Equal Consideration" Deadline for your Ontario College Application was February1st, 2022. Students can still apply. Please see your counselor if you need support.

Community Service Hours

We would also like to remind our learning community that there is a process in place for Community Service Hours. All graduating students must complete 20 community hours to obtain their Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The Guidance department must approve your community service opportunity before you start your hours. It should be at a Not-For-Profit organization.
