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
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Introducing our First Production this semester - Grade 9 /10 Drama Show of Appropriate Audience Behavior by Ian McWethy.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

To be considered for early admission into the program, please submit your completed application no later than Friday, December 15th by 4 pm to Thornlea's main office. Students will be notified of their early acceptance in December before the Winter Holidays. All other applicants will be put on a waiting list and notified

by late January if there are spaces available in the program. We do accept applications on an ongoing basis after January but space is very limited. It is best to apply early. Once accepted into the program register to

guarantee your spot! There is no cost to apply. The Application form is on the Thornlea School Website under "Specialized Programs" and "ACAM". If you are a York Region Student, you can apply online or with a printed copy. All other applicants can print a copy of the application and submit to Thornlea Secondary School (main office). 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GUIDANCE NEWS

Full Disclosure and OUAC/OCAS

Important Notice for all grade 12's that have applied to, or are planning to apply to OUAC (Ontario University Application Centre) for University and OCAS (Ontario Colleges Application Services) for College.

Your midterm grades from semester 1 have been processed by OUAC and OCAS and sent to the Universities and Colleges to which you have officially applied to. To date we currently have 3 students who have paid and applied to an Ontario College and 59 students have paid and applied to an Ontario University.

Please log on to your online application in order to review your academic information. This verification is especially important if OUAC/OCAS does not have a valid email address on file, or you are not able to receive emails from OUAC/OCAS or Universities/Colleges because of a junk-mail setting with your inbox.

If you see an error in your OUAC and/or OCAS file, it is very important that you contact your Guidance Counsellor as soon as possible to have it corrected.

Reminder: Equal Consideration Deadline for applications to Ontario Universities is January 15, 2024

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
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
