

Every Student Counts Survey – Students with Period 1 Spare

The Every Student Counts Survey will be administered in Period 1 classes from Friday, April 28 – Tuesday, May 9. If your child does not have a class during Period 1, they can pick up their letter with the unique survey code at the Main Office. The survey can then be completed at home or in the Library during Period 1 throughout the administration window mentioned above.

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June Exams

Exams will occur in some courses during the Exam/Culminating Week on the School Website Calendar which is Tuesday, June 20 - Tuesday, June 27, 2023. These dates are published early in the school year to assist families with planning as students are expected to be available. Planned absences (e.g., family vacations/trips, summer camp/employment, etc.) are not considered valid reasons to miss exams and should be planned outside of the published exam period. Monday, June 26 – Period 4 Exams (Grade 9-11 courses only)

Tuesday, June 27 - Exam / Culminating Activities

To register for a summer school course, you will need to login into your My Pathway Planner (also known as MyBlueprint).

Once you are in the Planner, you will need to:

Click on the "Continuing Education" button in the left-hand navigation menu Click on "Explore Courses" button

Review the course options that are available. Click the "submit course" button for the course you would like to take in summer school. **The closest "in-person" location to Thornlea S.S. is: Richmond Green S.S.**

Your Guidance Counselor will review your course selection for summer school once you either drop off the signed Sign Off form at the Guidance office or an email from a parent/guardian (using the email that is on school file) that they approve your summer school course selection. Once approved, you will see the word "Approved" beside the course you selected. I hope this helps.

Full Disclosure

Students will have five instructional days after mid term report cards are issued to consider withdrawing from a course. If a student withdraws from a Grade 11 or 12 prior to the full disclosure date the course will not be recorded on the Ontario Student transcript. If a student withdraws from a Grade 11 or 12 course after the Full Disclosure date, a withdrawal (W) is entered in the credit column, and the student's mark at the time of withdrawal will be recorded as a percentage in the achievement column of the transcript.

- 2) Login using your Student YRDSB login




3) Click Login button

 Functions

 MCR3UI Mathematics University

 This course introduces the mathematical concept of the function by extending students experiences with linear and quadrate relations. Students will investigate properties of discrete and continuous functions, including trigonometric and exponential functions; represent functions immersically, apletically, and graphically, solve problems involving applications of functions, and develop facility in simplifying polynomial and rational expressions. Students will reason mathematically and communicate their thinking as they solve multi-step problems.

- 7) Once you've selected the course that you would like to take in Night School or Summer School, you will see Submitted beside the course that you chose. You can still review and change your selection until it has been reviewed and approved by your counsellor.
- 8) Once your course selection has been approved, you will see the word **Approved** beside the course that you selected. Once approved, you will have to see your counsellor to make changes to your selection.

SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS

York Region Public Health is returning to your child's school for an immunization clinic for Hepatitis B, Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) & Meningococcal vaccines. Vaccines are available for free to students in grades 7-12.

The Scheduled clinic day is **MONDAY MAY 1, 2023**

A new consent submission **IS NOT** required for students who received vaccines at school in fall of 2022.
