As almost everyone is aware we have had a threat written in a gym bathroom stall. The threat said that there would be a shooting at school on May 24th. When the threat was discovered the police were immediately contacted and they investigated the situation. As an extra precaution there has been a police presence at our school throughout the day. We have locked our exterior doors after 9:15 and Administration has been at the doors with police. We believe that the message in the stall was a hoax but have taken every precaution to keep our students and staff safe. I have spoken and responded to many parents in the last few days and will get to your calls and emails as quickly as I can.

We would like to welcome back our Outdoor Education students who canoed and portaged through Algonquin Park with Mr. Hutchison, Ms. Bendavid and Mr. Poole. The students had a great experience last week as they travelled through one of Ontario's most beautiful provincial parks. The trip is like a final exam for the students and requires that they put all the knowledge that have learned in the course into action as they travel through the park by canoe.

There are several big events taking place in the next couple of weeks. Our students have planned a Wellness Fair, there is the Prom which will take place June 1st. Other events in June include the school production of Anne of Green Gables, Luminary awards and our Athletic banquet.

In the coming weeks our teachers will be calling home to let parents know that it is not too late to hand in missing assignments and to start preparing for final projects and exams.





Reminder to submit your volunteer hours to the Guidance Secretary. Important Timelines for OUAC (Ontario Universities Application
Centre): May 29, 2023
The latest date all high school applicants who submitted their application by the January application deadline can expect a response from an Ontario university. This includes an offer of admission, a refusal or a deferral, once additional information is received.
June 1, 2023 The earliest date an Ontario high school student may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.). All other admission-related elements, including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence, are considered part of the offer of admission. Therefore, a student may accept these other offers before June 1, 2023, but Ontario universities will not compel a student in any way to make a decision earlier than this date.
June 5, 2023 The date the Admission Information Service (AIS) opens. The AIS allows you to determine which Ontario universities still have spots available in first-year undergraduate programs.
Important Timelines for OCAS (Ontario Colleges Application
Services):
June 2023 : Tuition Deposit Due at the Colleges The colleges require payment of a tuition deposit in June to secure your spot in your program. Each college sets its own tuition deposit amount and payment deadline. This information will be communicated to you by the college.
