Message from the Principal

Dear Thornlea Families,

I would like to welcome you back to a very different school year. We have now completed one full week of classes with all students in attendance. If you are wondering we have a little less than 400 students attending each day. Our guidance department has been making course changes for students the past two weeks. They hope to be done today and or Monday of next week at the latest. To make you understand the problem we have faced over 270 students have transferred to the Virtual High School and many International Students have not returned to school at all this year. This has had a major impact on our timetable. We were forced to cut thirty three classes and we now have eleven fewer teachers this year compared to last. For the most part we have been able to provide students with their required classes but many elective courses were cut from our timetable. Many families are requesting a transfer into Virtual School. The school has passed on these requests to the School Board and we hope to have a response to these requests next week.

I am pleased to report that students are adapting to all the rule changes here at school. The school has hand sanitizer at each entrance and medical masks for any student that forgets their mask at home or leaves it in their ride. The school board has added extra caretaking staff to our school. To keep your children safe we are cleaning all touch points in the school multiple times a day. All door handles, desks and tables are cleaned and sanitized. Students are being dismissed at different times to reduce crowding in the halls. If you any questions or concerns in this area please feel free to contact me at any time.

On Monday September 28th students will begin their second rotation. They will see their period two teacher in person and will be doing periods 1, 3 and 4 online in the afternoon. The students are once again divided into cohort A and B. Some student's cohorts will move from what they had in the first rotation. We have kept siblings together and have honoured individual requests in this area. Next week, we have a School Council meeting on Monday at 7:00 p.m. and Grade 10 to 12 information meeting on Wednesday from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. Both meetings will take place on Go to Meeting.

Credit International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) Classes Registration Open until <u>September 26</u>

Dear Families,

The International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) program provides elementary and secondary students with the opportunity to speak, read and write a new language or maintain heritage language and culture. Due to the pandemic, International and Indigenous Language classes for grades 9 to 12 students will take place **online**, not in the school buildings. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language class.

IMPORTANT CHANGES REGARDING PROGRAM DELIVERY – SEPTEMBER 2020

Due to the pandemic, International and Indigenous Language classes for grades 9 to Grade 12 students will take place online, not in the school buildings. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language class.

What does this mean? Your child will use Google classroom to see the teacher teach the live lesson during the regularly scheduled language class.

If a student is not able to participate in a live lesson during the regular scheduled class, alternative asynchronous support is provided to ensure the student has access to the online learning (e.g., posting of prerecorded material or tasks for reference at a later time).

We look forward to providing engaging, online language learning through our Google Classrooms until normal in class language instruction resumes.

FEES

A \$20 consumable fee will be collected when schools reopen for International and Indigenous Language classes and normal in class language instruction resumes. International fee-paying visa students are required to pay an additional \$500 for registration, plus consumable fees.

Did you know there are many benefits to taking credit language courses?

- Students can take one International Languages Course as a Group 1- Compulsory or as an Elective Credit towards their Ontario Secondary Diploma.
- Students in the Secondary International Languages program can earn up to three credits towards graduation.
- If students successfully complete the Level D University course, it can be used as one of their top six marks for post-secondary entry. For example, if a student takes Spanish Level B, C and D, the student can submit their Level D mark as one of the top six marks for post-secondary applications.
