To register for a summer school course, you will need to login into your My Pathway Planner (also known as MyBlueprint).

Once you are in the Planner, you will need to:

Click on the "Continuing Education" button in the left-hand navigation menu Click on "Explore Courses" button

Review the course options that are available. Click the "submit course" button for the course you would like to take in summer school. **The closest "in-person"**

Your Guidance Counselor will review your course selection for summer school once you either drop off the signed Sign Off form at the Guidance office or an email from a parent/guardian (using the email that is on school file) that they approve your summer school course selection. Once approved, you will see the word "Approved" beside the course you selected. I hope this helps.

Full Disclosure

Students will have five instructional days after mid term report cards are issued to consider withdrawing from a course. If a student withdraws from a Grade 11 or 12 prior to the full disclosure date the course will not be recorded on the Ontario Student transcript. If a student withdraws from a Grade 11 or 12 course after the Full Disclosure date, a withdrawal (W) is entered in the credit column, and the student's mark at the time of withdrawal will be recorded as a percentage in the achievement column of the transcript.

SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS

York Region Public Health is returning to your child's school for an immunization clinic for Hepatitis B, Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) & Meningococcal vaccines. Vaccines are available for free to students in grades 7-12.

The Scheduled clinic day is **MONDAY MAY 1, 2023**

A new consent submission **<u>IS NOT</u>** required for students who received vaccines at school in fall of 2022.
