Presentation is available for Colleges as well under Guidance-Post secondary education-College.</p> <p>-The presentation was shared last week with all grade 12 students</p> <p>Today's discussions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Oct.17-all grade 12 students received their pin # -Based on statistics students apply in average to 5 programs. -There are top 6 courses that universities take in account (English is one of them). -Besides the academic achievements, students should look at building their portfolio for non academic stuff. Apply as soon as you can so that you can get information on what is needed.
