## THE SCHOOL COUNCIL VOICES CONCERNS

For the past 2 years, our children have been through unprecedented and challenging times. Luckily, most school activities and events are now back and better than ever!

In response to the dispute between the Ontario government and CUPE, the School Council sent a letter to Premier Doug Ford, Minister Stephen Lecce (Minister of Education), Laura Smith and Logan Kanapathi (Members of Provincial Parliament), David Sherman (YRDSB Trustee), and Grant Fawthrop (Superintendent) on November 3rd to express our concerns and request the parties to return to the bargaining table and negotiate a fair contract, so that our children can return to school in person as soon as possible.

The contract negotiation is still a fluid situation, and we sincerely hope that the school life of our children will not be disrupted again.
