



- Some programs may ask for a Gr. 11 or Gr. 12
 Math
- Some programs may ask for a Gr. 11 or Gr.12
 Biology/Chemistry and/or Physics

- Complete any additional requirements:
- Auditions, portfolio submissions, supplementary application/information forms, and/or essays, etc.
- Careful make sure to follow all deadlines, do not be late.


Admission Requirements - Part 3

- Contact student services if applicable
- IEP, special circumstances, mental health issues, etc.
- Many offer programs over the summer or before the new school year begins
- Contact them as soon as you apply

On-Line Application Process




- Research colleges

Fees:

- Up to a maximum of five choices \$95.00
- No more than 3 programs at any one college
- OEN Number and Legal Name
- All Fees are Non-Refundable
- You must pay for each change
- Apply for appropriate programs

- o Will communicate any next steps, extra requirements, financial information
- O Will offer admission (official confirmation through OCAS only!)

Mark Your Calendar

November 1, 2022: Earliest Offer Date

• This is the earliest date that colleges may begin to send offers of admission to programs for the upcoming academic year. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or wait-lists are established.

February 1, 2023: Equal Consideration Date

- Apply on or before this date in order to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, colleges consider applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until programs are full.
- Note that applications to <u>Highly Competitive Programs</u> must be received by this date in order to be considered. As these programs receive a high volume of applicants, all seats may be filled by February 1.
- Applicants are encouraged to complete their applications well before the Equal Consideration Date, as website volumes on the online application are at their highest at this time.
- Many programs continue to accept applicants after February 1. Use our <u>Find a Program</u> tool at any time to find programs that are still open.

May 1, 2023: Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission

- Applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by this date. Log in to your ontariocolleges.ca account to confirm your offer.
- Colleges may extend offers of admission after this date. Each college will set the deadline to confirm offers
 made after May 1, and this deadline will be communicated to you with your offer.

June 2023: Tuition Deposit Due at the Colleges

- The colleges require payment of a tuition deposit in June to secure your spot in your program. Each college sets its own tuition deposit amount and payment deadline. This information will be communicated to you by the college.

Paying for Your Application

You can pay for your application three ways:

- Online. With Visa (including Visa Debit), MasterCard or American Express. (Recommended)
- By phone. You can <u>contact us</u> to pay over the phone using a credit card. We accept Visa (including Visa Debit), MasterCard and American Express.
- Mailing a certified cheque / money order. Make the certified cheque or money order payable to 'ontariocolleges.ca' and be sure to include your 9-digit application number as well.
