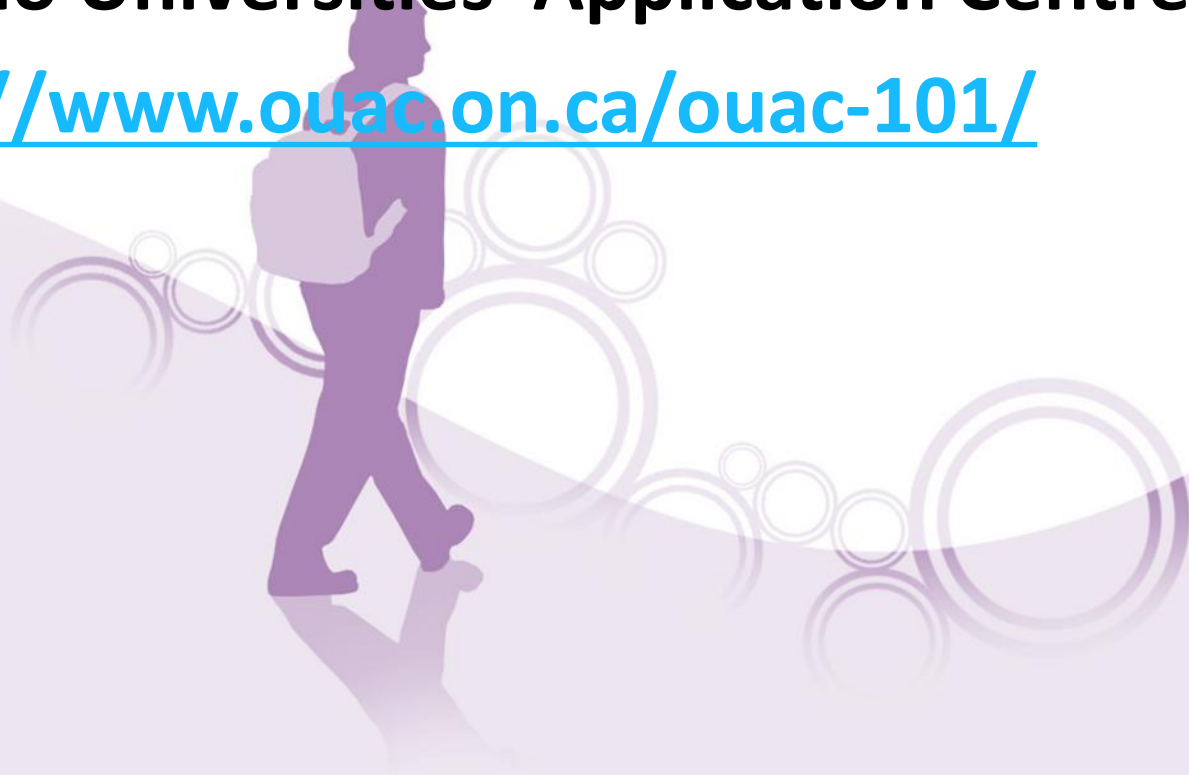

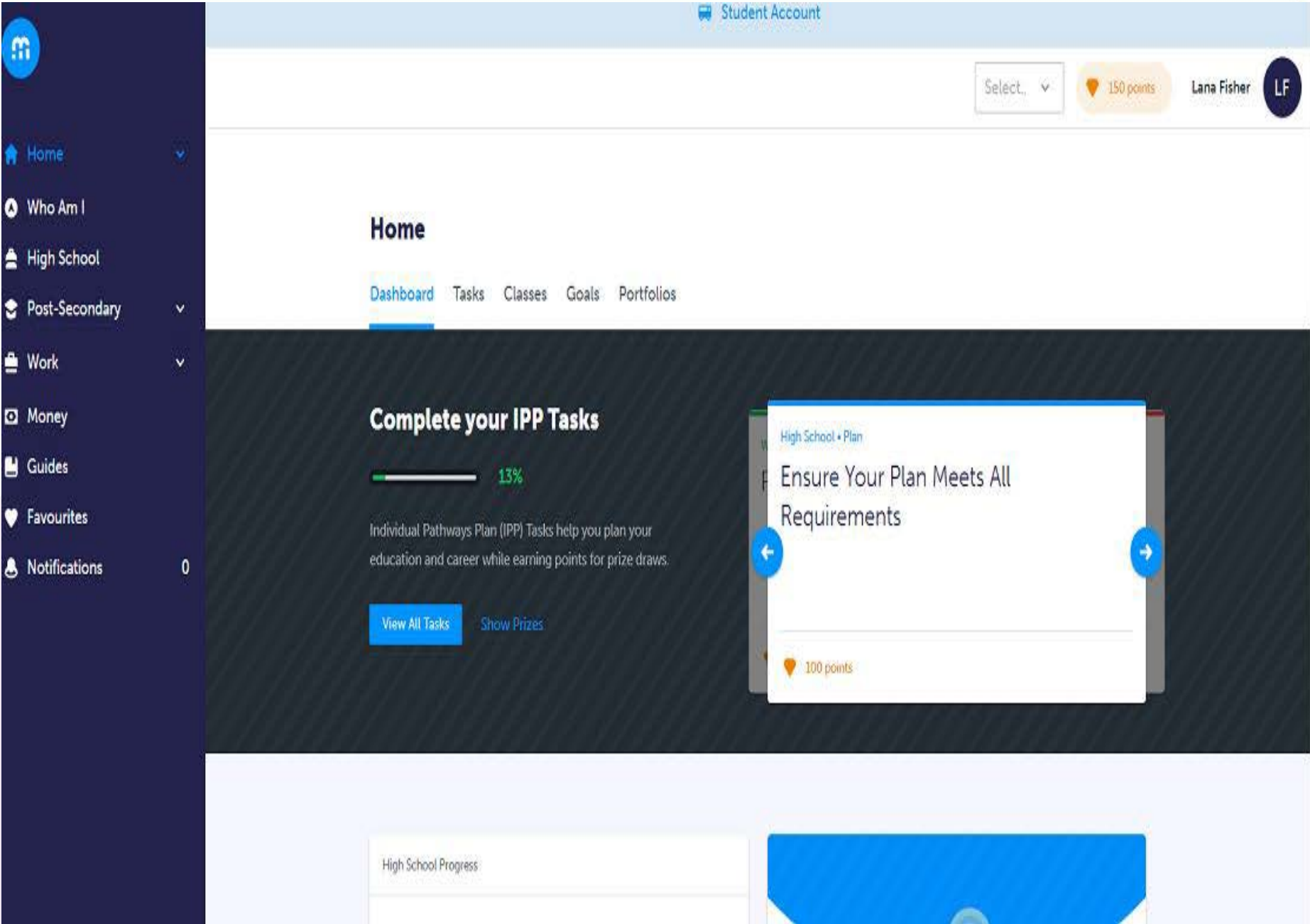

# Admission Requirements -Part 1

- **6** University (U) or University/College (M) courses, including English and ***program specific requirements***



# Admission Requirements -Part 2

- Complete any additional requirements:
- Auditions, portfolio submissions, supplementary application/information forms, and/or essays, etc.
- Follow all deadlines carefully



# Admission Requirements -Part 3

- Most universities request a Language Proficiency Test for students whose 1st language is not English (4 year rule - *double check*)
- You should have these results sent **before** January 12

# Admission Requirements -Part 4

- Contact Student Services if applicable
- IEP, special circumstances, mental health issues, etc.
- Many offer programs over the summer or before the new school year begins
- Contact them as soon as you apply



## Decision Making...Ontario

- Decisions are released during three main admission rounds: February, March, & May
- Offers of admission are based on appropriate Grade 11 and semester 1 Grade 12 marks
- All Gr. 11 finals are “considered” and Grade 12 finals/midterms (in progress), with an emphasis on courses relevant to the specific program

# Early Acceptance? Myth or Fact

- **Early Conditional Offers(fact or fiction?)**
- Based on Grade 11 prerequisite marks
- Not a separate application
- Eg. Queen's University -95%
- December 1<sup>st</sup> to Early February (very limited)

# When Will I Receive My University Acceptance?



- **\*\*For Some Programs\*\*** just a guideline:
- 5-10% of acceptances in early to late February
- 10-20% of acceptances in March -early April
- 60% of acceptances in late-April (after midterms)
- 10% of acceptances and offers from waitlists in May



# On-Line Application Process



- **Step 1: Get Your OUAC Access Codes**
- YRDSB will email you a confidential letter to your gapps email containing your access codes:

- These numbers allow you to access your 101 Online Application.
- ***Your PIN is confidential! Don't share it with anyone.***





- **Step 2: Research Your University Options**
- ☐ Visit **OUI**([www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca](http://www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca)) to see what each university has to offer.
- ☐ Read the **101 Application Guide**(available at <https://www.ouac.on.ca/101-tutorials/>) for information
- ☐ Check out university publications, websites and tours.
- ☐ Talk to counsellors, family, teachers and friends.
- ☐ Write down your program choices and **codes**, and keep them handy.



- **Step 3: Mark Your Calendar**
- ☐ week of **October 17, 2022:YRDSB** - distribute PINS
- ☐**January 12, 2023:** Deadline to submit your *completed & paid* application to the OUAC.
- ☐**May 29, 2023:** Latest date you can expect a response to your application for admission.
- ☐**June 1, 2023:** The earliest date you may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).



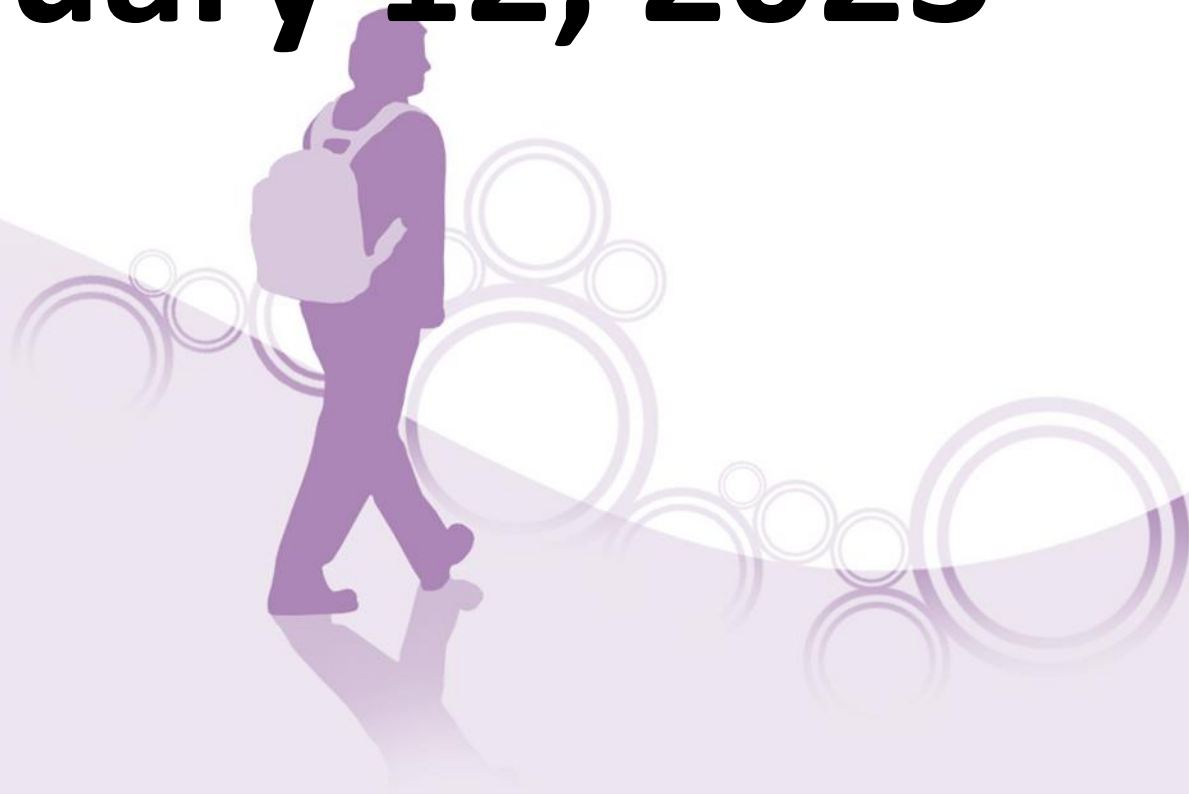

- Semester 1 Mid-term Marks (Nov. 19 transmission)
- Semester 1 Final Marks
- Semester 2 Mid-term Marks
- Semester 2 Final Marks
- Exceptions: summer school(Aug 2022), deferrals

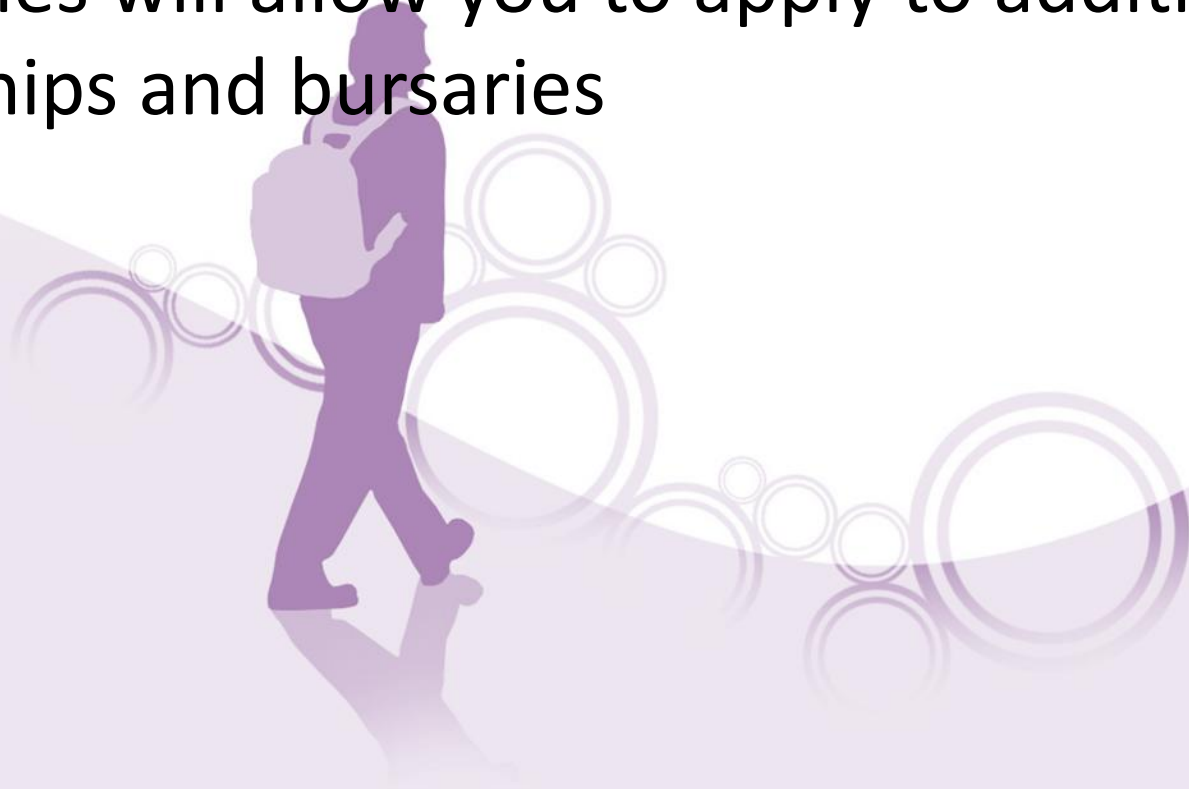

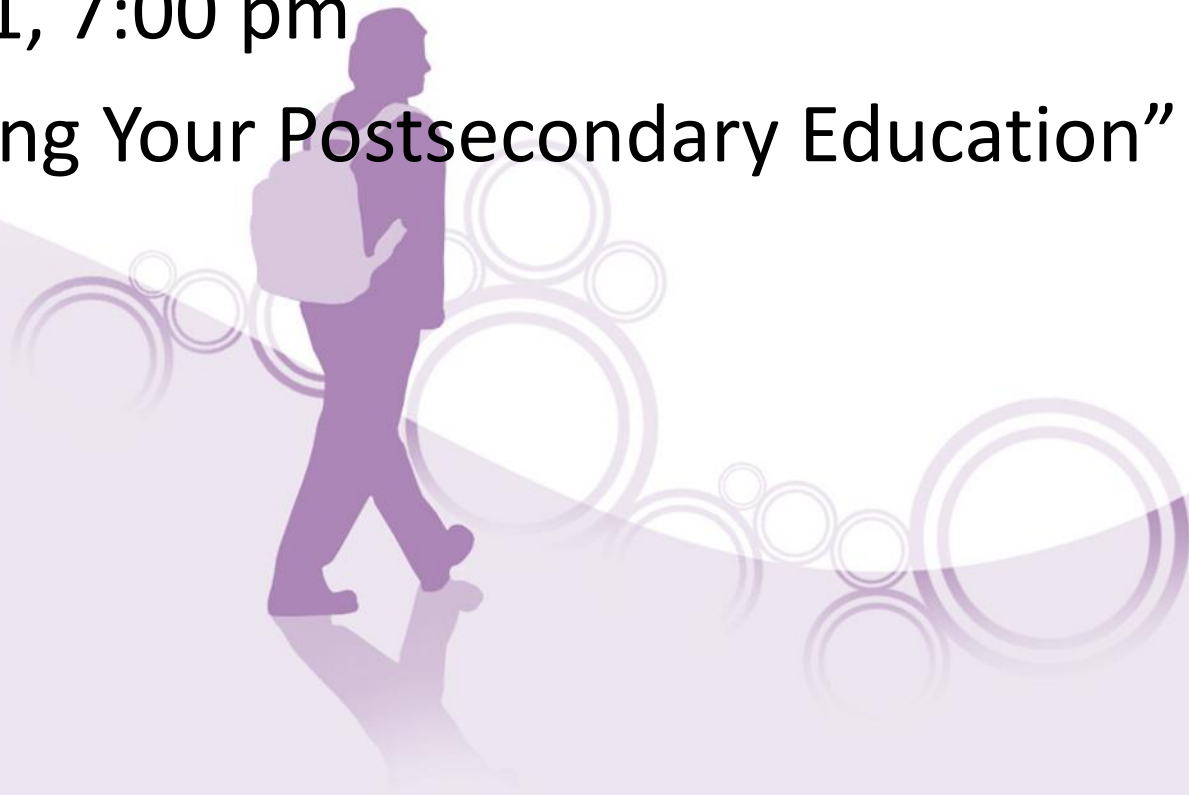
