#### Principal's Report (Sandra Sardone)

- Hot Topic! Timetable change set for September 2023, moves to 5 periods at 75-mins/each (8am 2:40pm) to accommodate high-volume. Currently at 1,700 Students/Staff.
- **Hold & Secure:** Occurred Thursday December 22, 2022. Students were safe and staff managed the quick call to action.
- **Hallway Blitz in action:** Staff looking out for students vaping, kids roaming the hallways during class time = disruptive to others. Hallway blitz looks to stop kids from missing instruction.
- **Cafeteria:** Hope to re-open in Sept 2023, unless the current vendor can accommodate staffing issues to open this school year.
