Chair Report (Amir Bigloo)

• **Traffic Issues around TDSS:** Several traffic-related issues in the neighborhood adjacent to TDSS, Johnny Lombardi Public School (JLPS) and Guardian Angels Catholic Elementary School (GACES) are longstanding.

To address the issues, a meeting was held with City Councilor Rosanna DeFrancesco, representatives from City of Vaughan, School Council and Admin representatives from JLPS, GACES and TDSS. The outcomes were:

- City of Vaughan will work to mitigate the speed issues in the neighborhood of the three schools
- City of Vaughan will work with TDSS on the upcoming No-Stopping Traffic Blitz on Major Mackenzie Drive in front of TDSS
- City of Vaughan suggested working with the Region of York for potential no-stopping signs in front of TDSS
