

Choosing ESL Courses

Students in ESLAO, BO, CO, or DO must **select TWO (2) levels of ESL**

Step 1: To choose the first level of ESL, click on the “+” sign in an Elective Box and choose the appropriate level of ESL.

This level will automatically go into the English Box on the course planner.

Step 2: To select the next level of ESL, repeat Step 1 by clicking on the “+” sign in the Elective Box and choose the second level of ESL.

Step 3: To select French (as all ESL students must complete a mandatory French Credit), click on the French Box, and select Core French FSF 101, which is the Open French for Beginners.

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Choosing French Immersion (FI) Courses

Students in the FI Program need to select the appropriate FI courses as part of their Grade 9 Course Selection package. In addition to the core courses outlined on Career Cruising, please follow the steps outlined below:

Step 1: Click on the “+” sign in the French Box to choose your French (FI) course — either Academic French (FIF1DF) or Applied French (FIF1PF)

Step 2: Click on the “+” sign in the Geography Box to choose the FI Geography Course — either Academic Geography (CGC1DF) or Applied Geography (CGC1PF)

Step 3: Click on the “+” sign in an Elective Box to select *at least one FI Elective*, either Visual Arts (AVI1OF), Business Studies (BTT1OF), and/or Guidance, Learning Strategies (GLS1OF)



Choosing Special Education Courses

Selecting Learning Strategies (GLE 101):

Click on the “+” sign in an Elective Box. Choose “Special Education” from the drop down menu and select “Learning Strategies (GLE101).”

Selecting Grade 9 Language LD:

Step 1: click on the “+” sign in the English Box, select Grade 9 Applied Language LD (ENG1PV). This will also automatically add Geography (CGC1PV), Math (MFM1PV), and Science (SNC1PV) to your course selection.

Step 2: Click on the “+” sign in an Elective Box. Choose “Special Education” from the drop down menu and select “Learning Strategies” (GLE101).

Step 3: Continue with the rest of the planner (to complete your Grade 9 Course Selection).
