Step 2: To select the next level of ESL, repeat Step 1 by clicking on the "+" sign in the <u>Elective Box</u> and choose the second level of ESL.

Choosing French Immersion (FI) Courses

Students in the FI Program need to select the appropriate FI courses as part of their Grade 9 Course Selection package. In addition to the core courses outlined on Career Cruising, please follow the steps outlined below:

Step 1: Click on the "+" sign in the <u>French Box</u> to choose your French (FI) course — either Academic French (FIF1DF) or Applied French (FIF1PF)
