The Award:

Mr. Wallace Joyce touched the lives of countless people in Markham. He was a champion of the arts and supported many organizations throughout his life. The Varley-McKay Art Foundation celebrates Wallace Joyce's contribution through an Award offered to any graduating high school student in York Region pursuing their studies in art at a post-secondary level.

The Wallace Joyce Scholarship is a \$1000 bursary created to support students from York Region pursuing their studies in art at a post-secondary level.

Eligibility:

- Graduating York Region high school student
- Pursuing art studies at a post-secondary level

Selection Process:

Students will submit their application package for the Wallace Joyce Scholarship Award. The Varley Art Gallery's Education Coordinator will lead the selection process and sit on the selection jury. The Education Coordinator will contact the successful applicant within a month of the application deadline. Scheduling permitting, a staff member from the Varley Art Gallery will announce the winner at the school's graduation ceremony.

- A completed application form
- A curriculum vitae
- A selection of the student's works (maximum of 3)
- A letter documenting the enrolment of the student in an art college or university
- A statement written by the student explaining their art practice
- A reference letter from their art teacher
