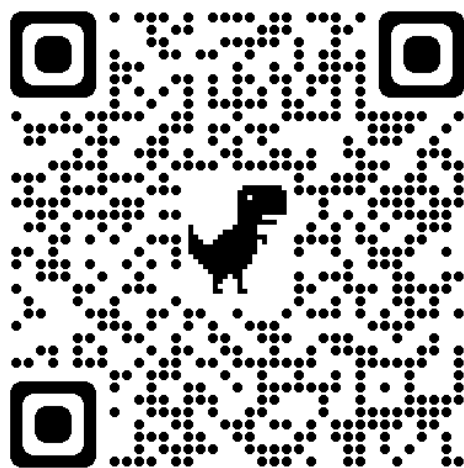

- guest speakers for Heritage months and spirit days

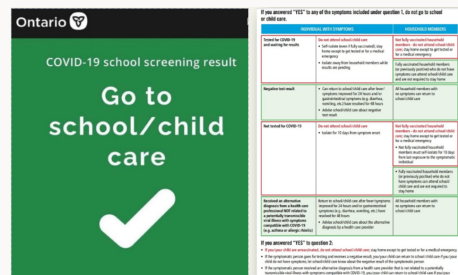

School Updates

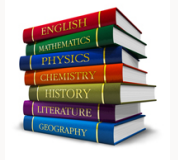
Self-Screening
