Graduation Information



Our graduation ceremony will still take place **on Monday**, **June 26**th at Pierre Elliott Trudeau High School, 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm.


Each graduate will be allotted 2 guest tickets (Grads do not need a ticket). Tickets will be distributed in early June.
