I am so looking forward to seeing what the new year brings to the Trudeau school community.

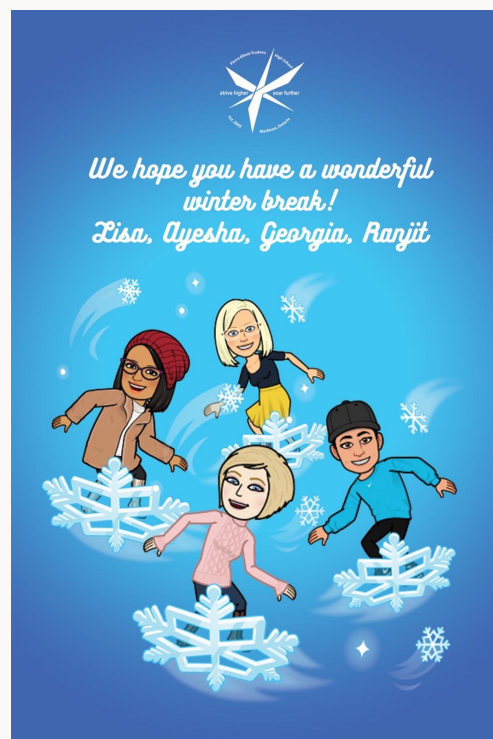
On behalf of the administration and entire school staff, I wish our families and students a safe and joyous holiday season and much happiness and peace for the New Year.

MOBYSS

We are fortunate this year to have the MOBYSS bus visit our school twice/month on Wednesdays. MOBYSS is Ontario's first mobile walk-in clinic for youth that provides primary care and mental health care to individuals between the ages of 12 and 25. Their services are completely free of charge, anonymous, and do not require a health card. The MOBYSS team includes a Nurse Practitioner, Youth Mental Health Worker, and Peer Support Specialist.





Attendance

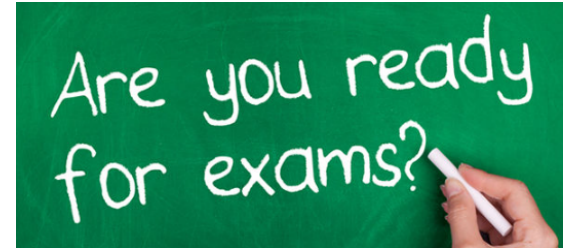
