Halloween Reminders for Families



The health and safety of our remains a top priority for us. **For students who wish to Halloween at school, please keep these reminders in mind when planning costumes:**

- Replica weapons of any kind are not allowed.
- Costumes should be respectful of others. Symbols or objects representative of a person's culture or religious beliefs should not be worn as a costume, nor should costumes that caricature social identities through stereotyping.
- Halloween masks are not to be worn and students should only use single-use make-up (no sharing of make-up)
- Costumes that depict violence, alcohol, or drugs are not permitted.

In the spirit of Truth and Reconciliation, it is important that costumes do not trivialize and devalue the lives of Indigenous peoples in Canada.


Take Your Kids to Work Day - November 2, 2022

MOBYSS

We are fortunate this year to have the MOBYSS bus visit our school twice/month on Wednesdays. MOBYSS is Ontario's first mobile walk-in clinic for youth that provides primary care and mental health care to individuals between the ages of 12 and 25. Their services are completely free of charge, anonymous, and do not require a health card. The MOBYSS team includes Nurse Practitioner, Youth Mental Health Worker, and Peer Support Specialist.
