Step 1

Go your school's OverDrive website: http://yrdsb.lib.overdrive.com

Step 2

Sign in with your student ID or school login. Students must add a zero in front of their student number. Staff must add 1000 in front of their employee number.

Step 3

Borrow a book.

Step 4

Go to your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**). From there, click the **Read** or **Listen** button to open the book in your browser.

OverDrive Read is a browser-based reader, and OverDrive Listen is a browser-based audiobook player. They don't require software or downloads; they just require an up-to-date web browser.
