What is paraphrasing?

Taking

someone else's ideas

and putting them in

your own words

An effective paraphrase keeps the **same core meaning** as the original passage.

But the meaning is expressed in your own personal voice.

It sounds like you.

Why should you paraphrase?

To show your **understanding** of the

information.

To avoid *quoting* too much.

To avoid **plagiarism**.

Plagiarism is...

- Copying words or ideas from someone else
- Rearranging, changing or adding a few words, but keeping the sentence structure essentially the same
- Failing to put a quotation in quotation marks
- Forgetting to cite your sources (give credit to the original author)

Plagiarism is cheating.

Replacing a few words with other words is still considered **plagiarism**

Inserting new words into the same sentence structure as the original is still considered

plagiarism

Changing only the sentence order is still considered **plagiarism**

An effective paraphrase has a **different sentence structure and uses different words** to convey the same meaning as the original text.

How to paraphrase effectively

text, but sounds like you!

Reread the original text until you understand its full meaning. Some ways to paraphrase: Combine Set the original aside. related ideas. Eliminate unnecessary Write your paraphrase without looking at words. the original text. Use synonyms. Check your paraphrase to see if it contains the main ideas of the original
