# Optimist International

- More than 2 500 optimist clubs in Canada, U.S.A., Caribbean, Europe, Asia, Africa

- Conducts 65 000 service projects annually
- Serves over 6 million young people
- Optimist programs include childhood cancer campaign, scholarship contests, teaching young people about internet safety, etc.

- Assembling craft kits and designing well-wishes cards for sick kids in hospitals around the world

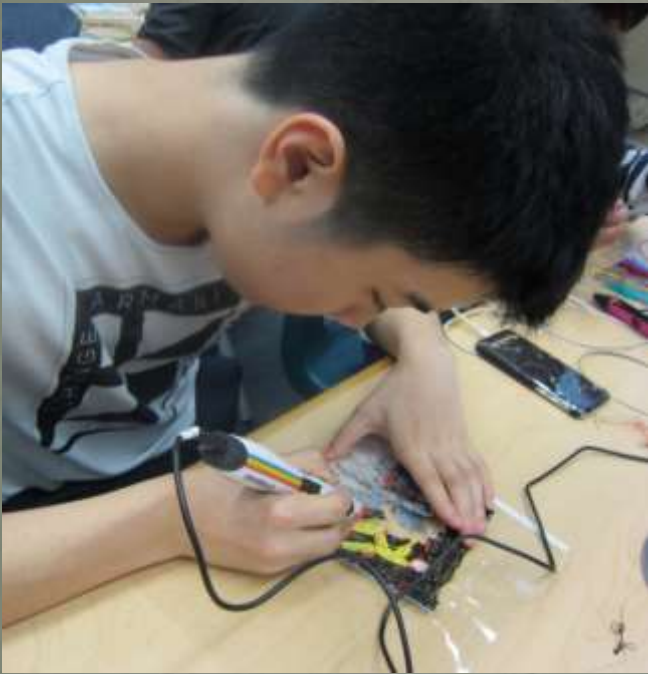


# Octagon Activities: Milk Bags for Mats

**Complete** application form.

**Submit** application form and membership fee (\$4 with student activity card, \$14 without student activity card) to Mrs. Yun-Lee in the Library.

**Check** your email regularly. If you do not receive an email within two weeks from Octagon Club, speak with Mrs. Yun-Lee.
