Parking Lot Student Drop Off Announcement

Emergency Fire Routes – NO PARKING is permitted at any time.

It is imperative that drivers using school parking lots do not park in emergency fire routes. The City of Markham will issue a \$200 fine for this violation.

The City of Markham By-Laws (#2008-1)state,

- No person shall park a motor vehicle on, or along, any part of a designated fire access route at any time.
- "Stop" or "Stopping" means the halting or leaving of a motor vehicle, even momentarily, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or of a traffic control sign or signal.

There is a "drop off/pick up" zone identified within the emergency fire route. This area can only be used when you are dropping off or picking up a student and you are not sitting, waiting for the student. The student must already be in this designed area, ready to be picked up.
