After School Literacy Program (OSSLT Prep)

The OSSLT test is coming on March 30, 2017. In order to best prepare our students for the test, the following program / workshops are available to your child.

- After School Literacy Program – This is an optional program for students to receive intensive practice with reading and writing skills. At the end of the program, each student will complete a checklist of strengths and needs. Signup is through School Cash Online. (Costs apply to international students only)
- OSSLT In Class Introduction – The Literacy Teacher will run an in-class introduction to OSSLT for all students that are writing the test.
- Literacy Boost – The Classroom Teacher will run in-class focused lessons to provide familiarity with key questions of the test
- Period 4 Lunch and Learn Workshop – This is an optional workshop for students to get extra practice and help in preparation of the test. It will happen from Feb. 27 to Mar. 28. Each workshop will have a themed focus on a particular section of the test. Details will be posted in class.
