As outlined in Board Policy and Procedure #152, Extreme Weather, Inclement Weather and Emergency Conditions Days:

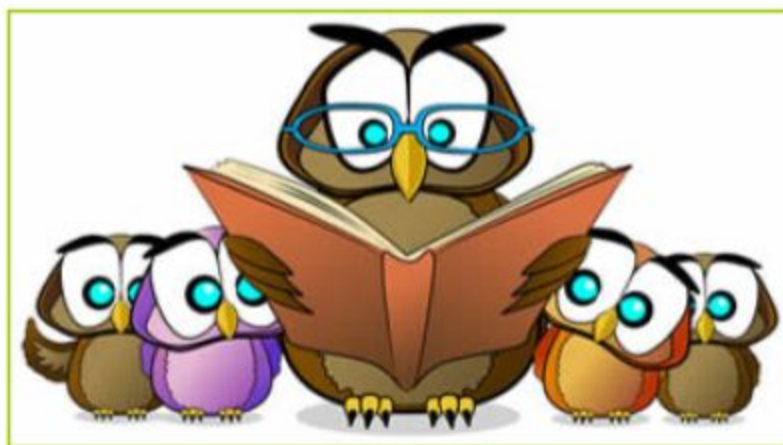

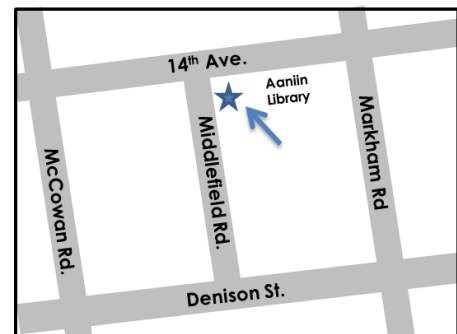
