Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test

The OSSLT test is runing through to Wednesday, November 29.

The test will be taken in Period 3 with Period 4 allotted for extra time should a student need it.

Grade 10, 11 and 12 students who are eligible to take the test have received letters confirming their status and participated in practice sessions. Any student who missed practice sessions should see the OSSLT Google Classroom (ejjweva).

Due to the outage, students have been receiving information through their GAPPS accounts and the OSSLT Google Classroom. Students may still join the Google Classroom using the code: ejjweva .
