## AU DANCE ~ ALICE



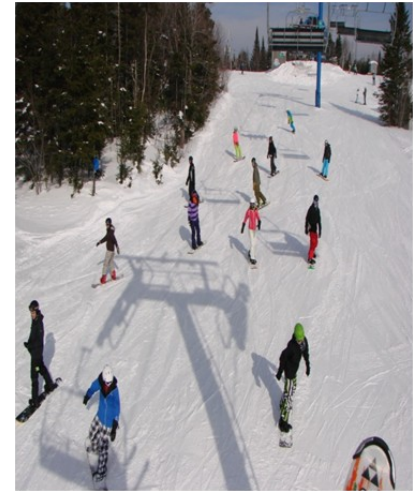

# FULL DISCLOSURE MEMO

## **Attention Students who have applied to post-secondary institutions:**

As you know, **full disclosure** applies to all grade 11 and 12 courses that a student is registered in for longer than "5 days following the first provincial report card". Our report card distribution date this year is November 18<sup>th</sup> and, therefore, our **full disclosure date is November 29<sup>th</sup>**.

All courses continued past **November 28<sup>th</sup>**, and marks earned to date in these courses, will be shown (fully disclosed) on your official transcript.

## **There is a process and specific criteria in place that must be followed for students to be considered to drop a course.**

Please note, this year report cards are being issued two working days before OCAS (Ontario Colleges Application Service) upload needs to be completed. As a result, if you are applying to an Ontario College and you do not want a course to be transferred to OCAS, your task is to start the process to drop the course as soon as possible by making an appointment with your Guidance Counsellor.

### **Summary of dates:**

- November 18 – deadline for students applying to a college to see alpha counsellor to drop a course
- November 21 – deadline for completed drop form for students applying to college due to Guidance by 3:00 p.m.
- November 22 - transfer of mid-term marks to OCAS
- November 24 - deadline to see student's alpha counsellor to drop a course (for university applicants)
- November 28 – deadline for completed drop form due to Guidance by 3:00 p.m. (for university applicants)
- **November 29 - official full disclosure date**

\*if you applying to both the colleges and universities, please follow the timelines for colleges.
