Take Our Kids to Work Day

Take Our Kids to Work (TOKW) Day is a unique initiative designed to provide Grade 9 students with invaluable insights into the world of work. It aims to assist students in considering future career paths by offering them the opportunity to observe a work environment for one day. On **Wednesday, November 1**, Grade 9 students will have the chance to spend the day at a workplace of their parent/guardian, relative, friend or volunteer. (Please note: UHS does not organize job shadowing placements for this day.) It is a day dedicated to fostering a deeper understanding of various career options and pathways. The Students Commission of Canada is the new organization that supports this program and offers resources for educators, students and families. The 2023 TOKW Theme is "Everyone Belongs Here!"

To support this nationwide job shadowing day, there will be no Grade 9 classes on this day. Parents and Guardians should have completed the TOKTW permission form.

For students unable to attend a job shadowing opportunity through a parent/guardian, relative, friend or volunteer, students will have two options: they may either complete virtual career exploration opportunities at home or may complete those same virtual opportunities at school. These virtual opportunities will be sent to the student's GAPPS account a few days prior to the day. For planning purposes, families should indicate this on the permission form above. If you have any questions, please speak with Ms. Imada-Chan, Vice-Principal.

Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test

All grade 10 students and previously eligible Grades 11 and 12 students will be taking this test for two days during their Period 3 class between **November 20-29**. More details forthcoming.

Students may access the presentation here and any Grade 10 teachers are also asked to post this presentation in their Google Classroom.

As this is a graduation requirement, any grade 11 and 12 students who attempted previously and did not pass the test may also write during this period. They will be contacted for more details.
