# \*\*Important Notice\*\*

As you are aware, CUPE members (caretakers, office staff, and EAs) are in a legal strike position and are planning to commence full strike action on Monday, October 7 if a deal cannot be reached. If the strike proceeds on Monday, October 7, 2019, all schools will be closed to students for the duration of the strike. This means that all transportation services (including buses and taxis) as well as before and after care programs are cancelled.

Cancellations also include the following:

- All Continuing Education Programs (e.g. Night School, International Languages)
- All e-Learning programs
- Home Instruction
- Aquatics Programs
- Student CO-OP Programs/Placements

Unfortunately, we cannot safely continue to keep our schools open to students if a strike occurs. This was not a decision made lightly. We recognize that this is inconvenient and difficult for all involved and we will keep families up to date with all available information.

Parents/Guardians must make alternate arrangements for their children prior to the strike.


