#### Parking at UHS

Please be aware that the school driveways and parking areas are very busy at Town Centre Blvd and Warden in the morning (8:00-8:30 am) and in the afternoon (2:00-2:35 pm). In the morning, please do not park in staff spaces at the Warden entrance. At Town Centre Blvd, you are advised not to park for an extended period in the "No Idle Cars" zone. This is also a Fire Route. This zone is intended only for "quick pick-up or drop-off." Cars that are parked or left idling in this zone can be ticketed by the City of Markham. As well, parking passes are required for all cars in our school lots. Cars without parking passes in our school lots will be ticketed by the City of Markham.

#### **Parking Passes for Students**

## Arts Unionville Fee for 2021-2022 (Returning Students - Grades 10, 11, and 12)

The annual program fee for Arts Unionville students of \$100 is payable upon acceptance to the program and then each school year thereafter as long as the student stays in the program. With the continued commitment to excellence in the Arts Unionville program, the annual \$100 Arts Unionville Fee supports an augmented learning experience over and above what is provided for students in a regular high school setting. This fee covers guest artists and life models, professional workshops, costumes and unique learning experiences. Some program enhancements can be provided virtually, such as guest artists. Payment in <u>School Cash Online</u> is due by September 30, 2021.

## Lockers

Most grade 10, 11 and 12 students received a GAPPS email containing their locker number and combination today. Students who have not yet been assigned a locker, including all grade 9 students and other students who are new to UHS, will receive their locker number from their Block Three (morning) teacher next week. Thank you for your patience as we complete the process of assigning lockers and combinations. All students will have a locker and combination no later than Friday, September 24. If students have difficulty with their combination after it has been assigned, they can visit the main office for assistance.

## Clubs , Safety Week, and Start-Up Permissions

There can be no scheduling of virtual club meetings until after Safety Week is over and club applications have been approved. Prior to starting clubs, students need to be reminded about the School Code of Conduct and The Acceptable Use of Technology Agreement. These topics will be covered in our Caring and Safe Schools Presentation that is scheduled for the week of September 27th. Also, prior to starting clubs, families need time to submit start-up permissions, which are now being sent out by the Board to students and families via email. Students who wish to participate in clubs should have submitted their start-up permissions. Lastly, before a club can commence, the teacher advisor needs to submit the club application form and receive approval. Students cannot submit this application. The first step to forming an official club is finding a staff advisor. Approval of club applications will commence as of October 1<sup>st</sup>. Once clubs are approved, they will be virtual until further notice. In-person club meetings may not take place at this time.

## **USAC: Student Life Website Launch and Upcoming Elections**

Daily announcements will be posted here so that they can be accessed by all students, including those who are remote. USAC elections will take place mid to late October.
