#### LUNCH & STUDY HALL

Lunch/Study hall will commence on Monday, September 21. Lunch/Study hall is optional for students and will provide them with a space in the school where they can attend their online periods. Lunch/Study Hall will be available to students only on the days they are attending class in person.

Those who stay for study hall must bring their own lunch. Food services are not being provided at the school and students are not permitted to go out for lunch and then return for study hall. Students will eat their own lunch and transition to synchronous learning beginning at 11:05 am and ending at 3:00 pm in the cafeteria. Seating will be assigned.

The purpose of lunch and study hall is to provide a space for students who do not have consistent access to broadband Wi-Fi at home and are in school that day for their in-person morning class. During lunch and study hall, students will not have in-person access to their own classroom teachers. Students who need to stay must be working on afternoon online courses while being supervised by a staff member. Students will be supervised to ensure safety. Supervision will focus on participants' adherence to all Public Health requirements including sitting 2-meters apart only with students in their morning class. During study hall, students must be respectful of the learning needs of all participants engaging in online classes. Students should use earphones and an appropriate volume while focusing on their learning.

Students interested in staying for lunch/study hall on Monday, September 21, must sign up in Teachassist by Sunday, September 20 at 11:59 pm. Students will have to sign up every time before the day they plan to stay. Students can sign up for only one day at a time and not for multiple days. Unfortunately, due to Health and Safety protocols, we cannot accommodate 'walk-ins.' Only those students who signed up prior to the 11:59 pm deadline on the day before will be allowed to participate in lunch/ study hall on the following day.

## **NIGHT SCHOOL**

#### Night School E-Learning

Prior to applying for a night e-learning course, students must receive permission from their home school by contacting their alpha Guidance counsellor. Once school permission is received, the student may apply online. Registration will remain open until Sept 20th on the <u>e-Learning website</u>. Students only qualify if they cannot get the course at UHS and have 3 or fewer courses on their timetable. Courses begin Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup>

#### **Regular Night School**

Please be advised that our traditional in class face-to-face Night School program will move to a remote learning delivery model. The program will be delivered virtually through remote learning which is a blend of synchronous (real-time) and asynchronous learning. Registration is now open until Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>, and the courses begin on Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>. Students can only apply if they cannot get the course during day school. Students apply through My Pathway Planner, print the Sign-Off form, have their parent/guardian sign and scan it or take a picture of it and send it to their alpha counsellor by email.

#### TEACHASSIST

In the past few weeks some students have shared concerns with IT Services regarding a student developed App named Teachassist YRDSB available at the App store. It is important to note that this is a student developed app and is not Board supported/endorsed. Teachassist does not have an official app in any app store and unfortunately cannot control the use of the name "teachassist" on any personal development accounts.

## PARKING

Please be aware that the school driveway is very busy in the mornings between 8:00 and 8:30 am. Do not stop your car in the "No Idle Cars" zone. This is also a **Fire Route.** Cars left idling may be ticketed. As well, parking passes are required for all cars. Cars that do not have a parking pass will be ticketed by the City of Markham.

### **INTERNATIONAL & INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES**

The International and Indigenous Languages (IIL) program provides elementary and secondary students with the opportunity to speak, read and write a new language or maintain heritage language and culture. Due to the pandemic, International and Indigenous Language classes for grades 9 to 12 will take place **online**, not in the school buildings. Teachers will teach live language lessons in real time using Google Classroom to provide both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities during the regularly scheduled language class.

#### PUBLIC TRANSIT

YRT has updated its bus route times to support this year's school schedule. <u>Please check the YRT website for more information</u>. Some buses have been rescheduled to coincide with the 11:00 am dismissal.

#### **SCHOOL ENTRY & DISMISSAL**

Classrooms will be opened 15 minutes before the first bell. Students will be allowed entry to the building as of **8:15 a.m**. Students may enter through one of four entry points below in a single file fashion while maintaining social distance:

- 1. Town Centre Blvd. (main entrance)
- 2. Warden (Cafeteria)
- 3. Caretaking (Music)
- 4. Small Gym/Tech Wing

All students must be wearing a mask and sanitize their hands as they enter. Doors at all four entry points will be locked at 8:45 am. Students who arrive before 8:45 am should proceed directly to class. **Students who arrive after 8:45 am must enter from Town Centre Blvd. only and report to the office prior to going to class**. Parents/ guardians cannot enter the building unless they have a pre-arranged appointment that has been approved by the principal.

Students are expected to leave the school and school property after their last scheduled class is completed at 11:00 am. Students may not socialize in corridors or the cafeteria and must leave the school directly. Students are expected to continue wearing a face covering until they leave school property. All students must sanitize their hands as they exit. Students can exit at one of five exit points:

- 1. Town Centre Blvd. (main entrance)
- 2. Warden (Cafeteria)
- 3. Caretaking (Music)
- 4. Small Gym/Tech Wing
- 5. New wing (stairwell 13)

Please note that dismissal may be staggered by grade or floor beginning at 10:50 in order to prevent crowding.
