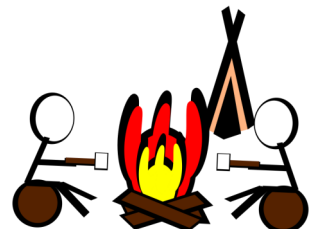
## I M P O R T A N T M E S S A G E S
