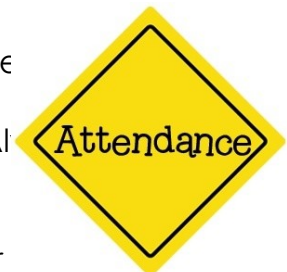
## Student Awards Celebration Breakfast October 4

### Grade 12 Students
